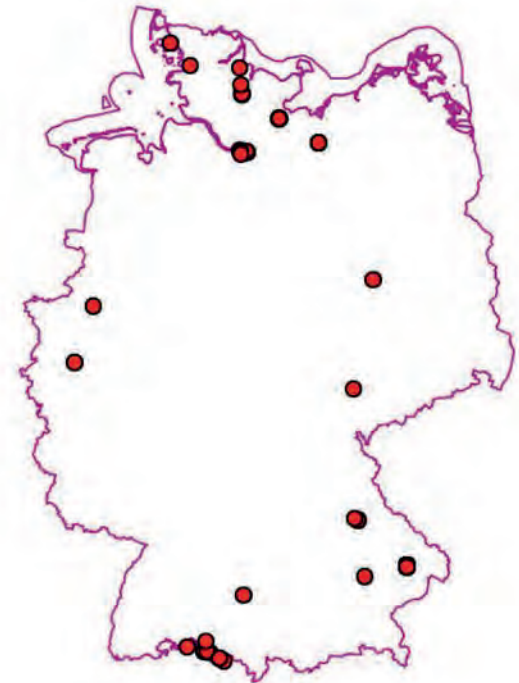
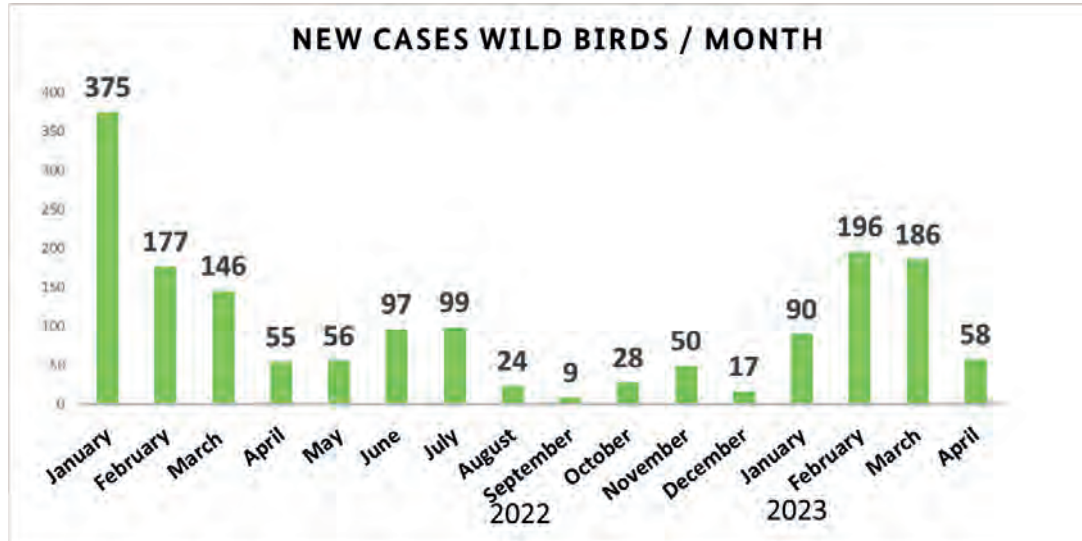

Evolution in wild birds

Decrease of HPAI cases in wild birds in April

2. Situation in **poultry** and **captive birds**

Period of time	Number of outbreaks
Active outbreaks on 21/04/2023 (13/02/2023)	47 (84)
New from 25-26/02/2023 (last PAFF) until 21/04/2023	21 Zoo: 2 Poultry: 10 NON-Poultry: 9
New season from 15/07/2022 until 21/04/2023	219 (172 lifted)



Evolution: Poultry and captive birds

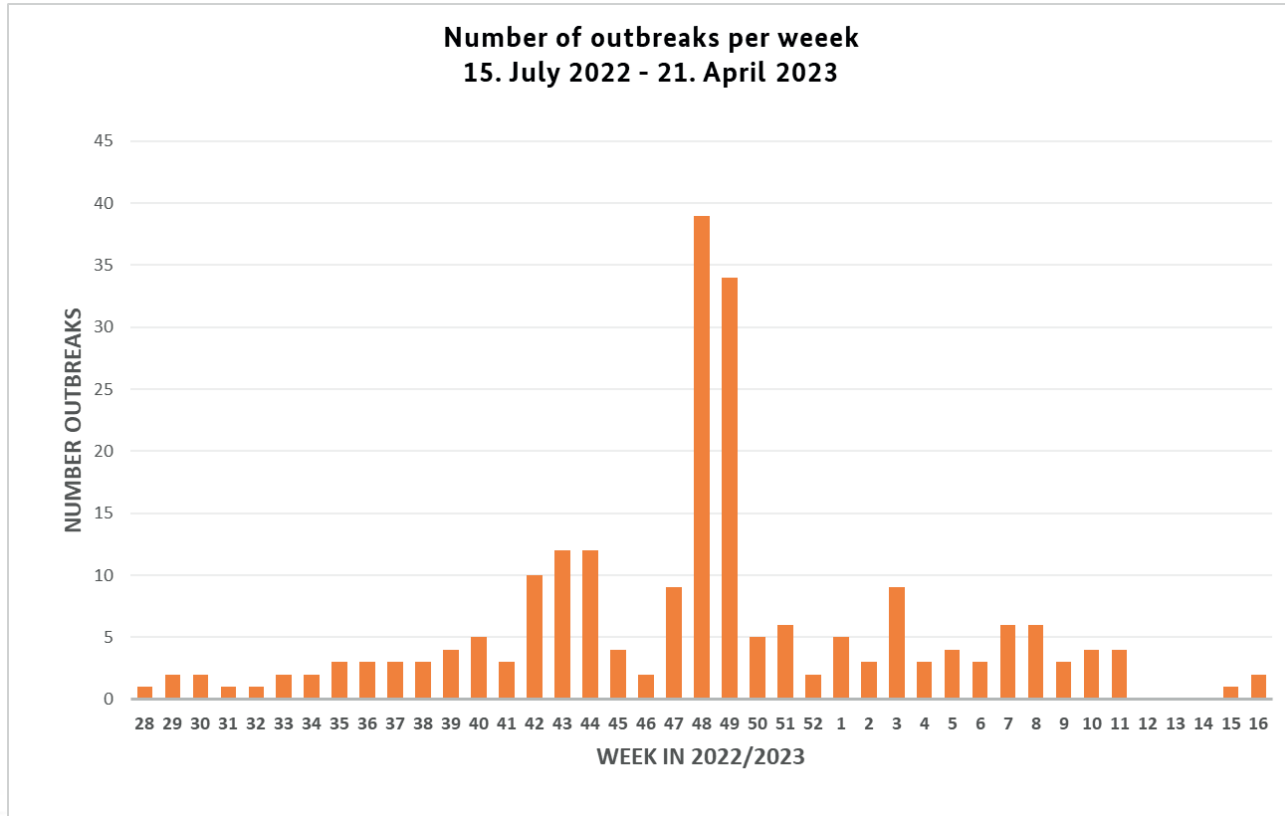
Active outbreaks on 21.4.2023

Outbreaks 13.2 up to 21.4 2023

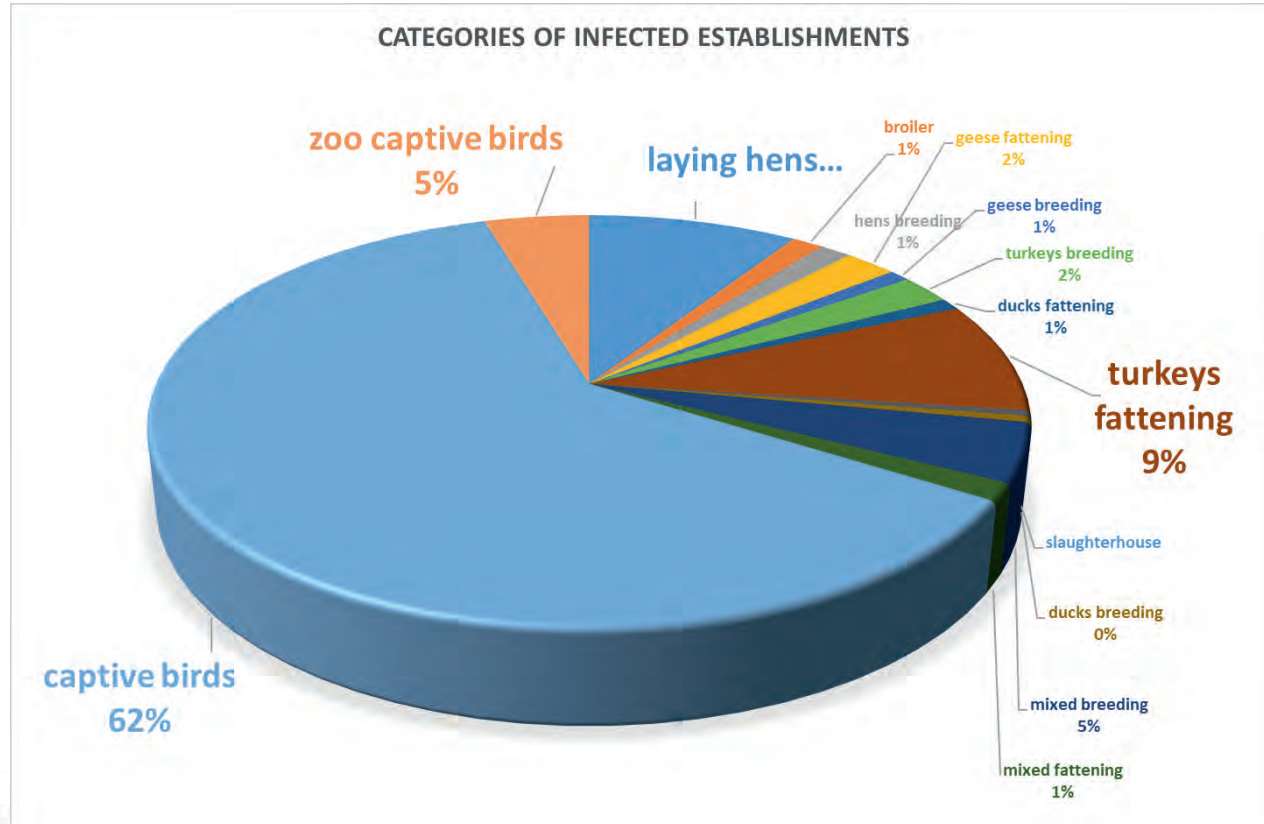
In several establishments the lifting of measures takes long due to the period necessary for the final disinfection of manure.

Infected establishments 15.7.2022 – 21.4.2023



Summary

- Number of cases in wild birds has decreased.
- Number of HPAI outbreaks in poultry and captive birds relative low.
- Biosecurity measures in place.
- Still essential: awareness.
