




Eionet Circular Economy and Resource Use Group

- Rationale of the group: Support the European Union's efforts to transition towards a more sustainable and circular economy.
- > Includes representatives from **EEA member** and cooperating countries (e.g., Ministries, government agencies, research institutions...).
- Example of ongoing **areas of work in 2023**: CE monitoring, sustainable consumption, waste prevention/management.



Eionet Food Systems Group

- Group officially launched in June 2022 as part of the Eionet modernization process
- Rationale of the group: to support activities addressing the sustainability of food systems in Europe
- Includes representatives from EEA member and cooperating countries (e.g., Ministries, government agencies, research institutions...)
- > Two ongoing areas of work in 2023:
 - Eionet working paper to gather evidence on national-level food system policies and strategies
 - Participatory food system mapping process



EEA's mandate on Waste prevention (WFD)



To publish, every two years, a report containing:

Assessment of the **progress** made in the completion and implementation of waste prevention programmes

Evolution of prevention of waste generation for each Member State and for the Union as a whole

An assessment of decoupling of waste generation from economic growth and the transition towards a circular economy











Efforts of food waste prevention in the EU-27 Member States - methodology
