

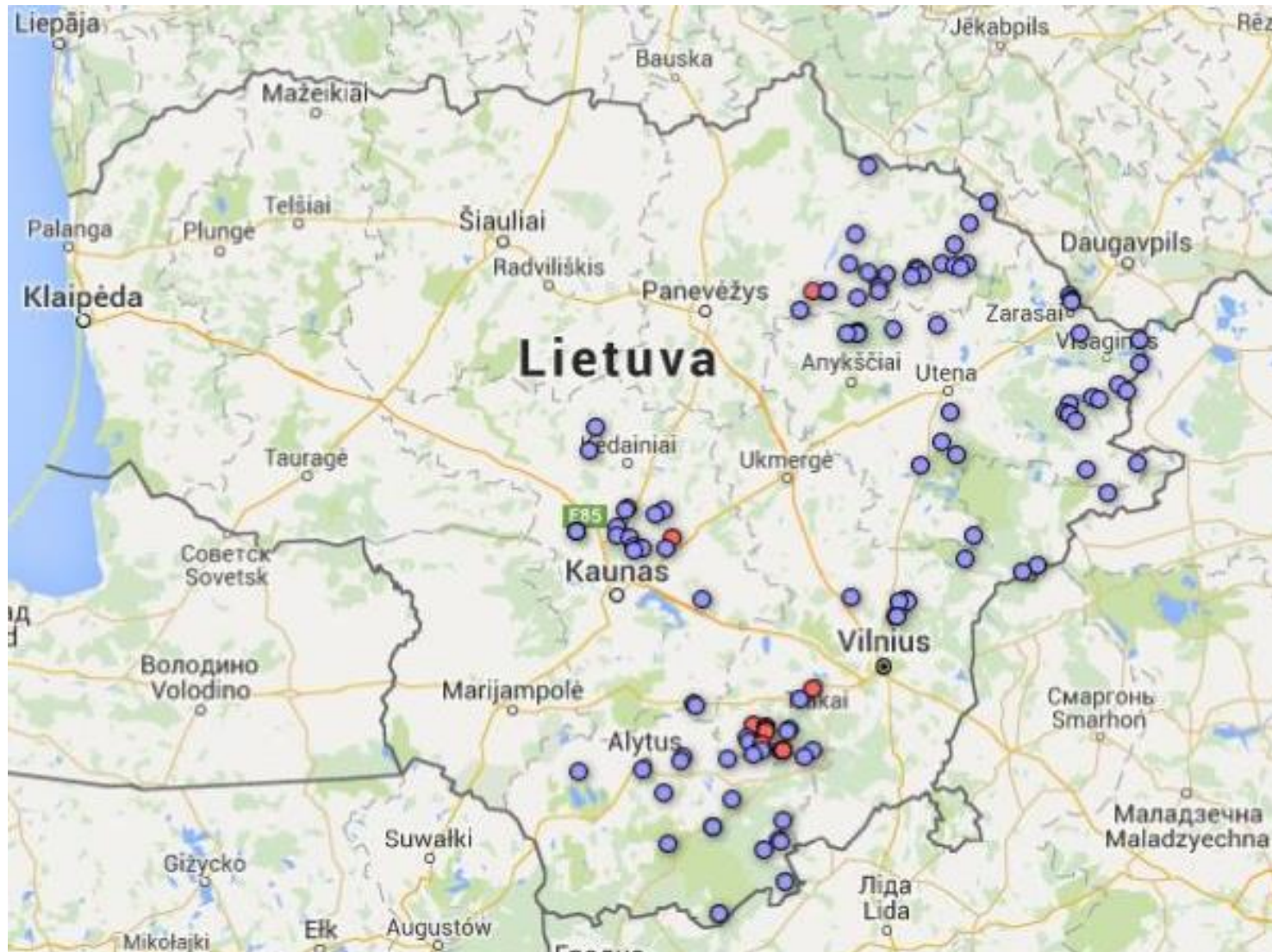

ASF cases in wild boars and outbreaks in pigs in 2015

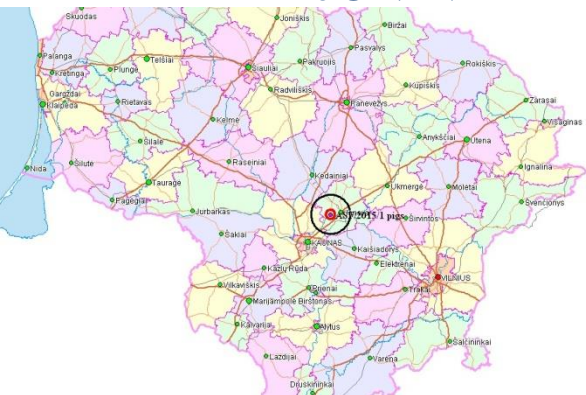


ASF outbreaks in pig keeping places in 2015

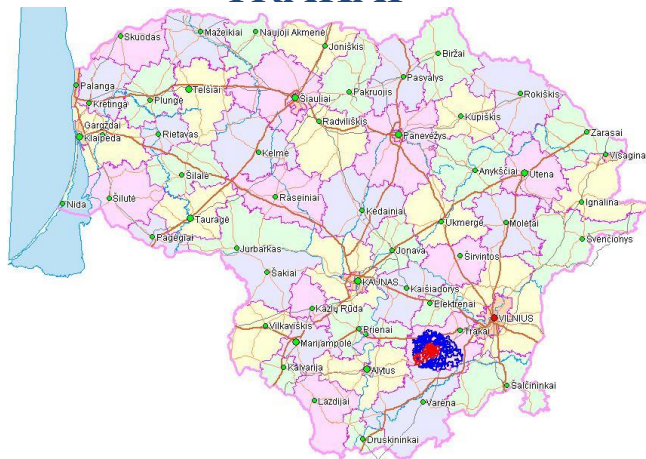

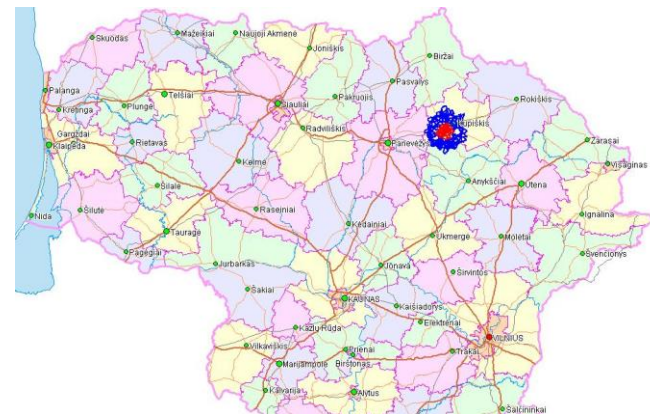

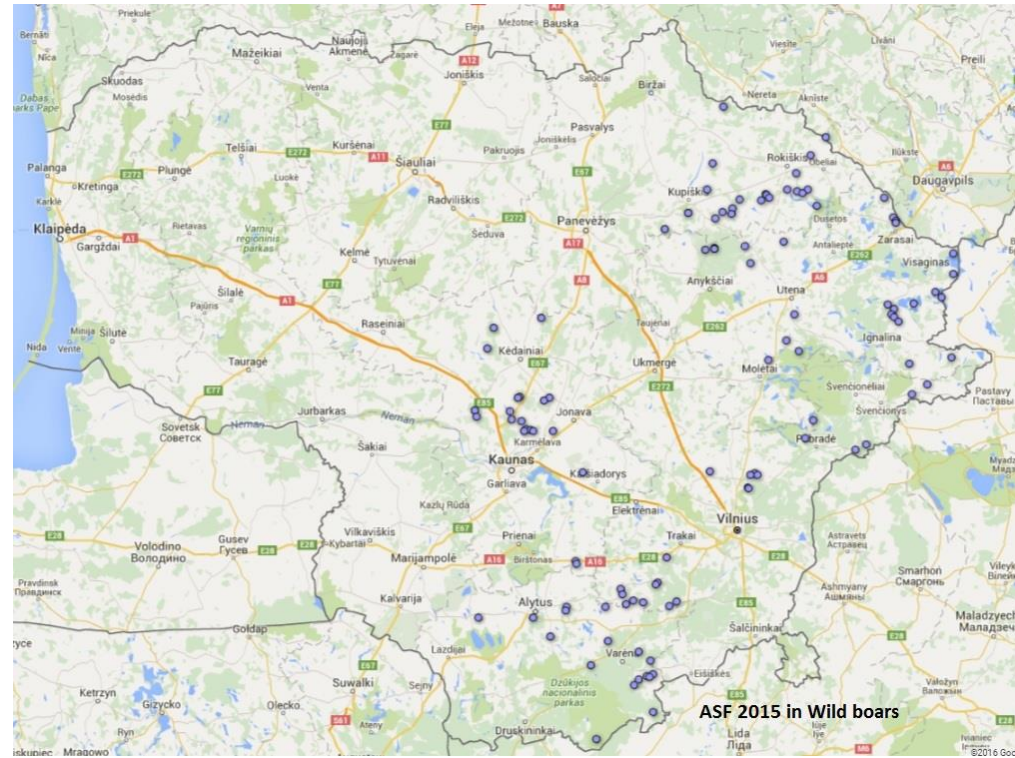


All outbreaks were confirmed in non-commercial farms !!!



ASF cases in wild boars

- 111 places
 - ASF was confirmed in 132 wild boars
 - 73 were hunted
 - 59 were found dead
- ASF is detected in 19 municipalities



Data on surveillance in 2015



13000 WB tested



25678 pigs tested

ELISA – 23023

PCR – 47780

Total testing - 70803

Compensations for hunters

- From **13 of November 2015**– Compensation for hunters for selective hunting of female wild boars.
- Hunters asked compensations for 1010 hunted wild boars female
- In 2015 for selective hunting LT authorities payed - 72250 EUR

Problems

- To perform an official control in non-commercial farms.
- On 2016-05-01 data in LT: 18 271 non-commercial farms are registered
- keeps from 1 to 10 pigs (58 270 pigs).
- SFVS would like to delegate to the private veterinarians the performance of control (biosecurity) in these farms.
- Financial support from EC to implement this measure 1 281 000 EUR (2 checks per year).



Lithuania would like to thank the EC for Grant Decision approving National Programmes and Associated funding. Also the other MS for their support.

Using the EC co-funding a lot of measures against ASF were implemented in entire country of Lithuania, such as:

- Sampling of pigs and wild boars
- Testing using Elisa and PCR methods
- Preventive slaughtering
- Compensation for targeted hunting
- Information campaign
- Other measures

From 2015 to 2016 ASF was confirmed in 19 municipalities. Good strategy and measures provides a possibility to control the ASF.

2015 Lithuania spent 1 747 782,62 EUR (EC co-funding – 1 147 094,53 EUR, ~ 65%).
