

ASF - EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION 01.01.2019 - 20.09.2019

Domestic pigs: 1394 outbreaks with 92062 affected pigs

from which, 22 infected commercial farms and 1372 infected backyards

Wild boars: 1498 positive cases from which, 1157 found dead and 341 hunted wild boars

PREVENTIVE CULLING 01.01.2019 - 20.09.2019

After a risk analysis is performed, to stop the spreading of the disease, the Local Centre for Disease Control can decide the preventive culling of pigs in a certain locality/area. Legal framework: Government Decision no. 484 from 5th of July 2018.

BIOSECURITY - DOMESTIC PIGS (1)

- Portable disinfection devices (for vehicles) and foot disinfectors (for pedestrians) are installed at the entrance and exit of markets, vegetable and fruit fairs
- Pig raising is **prohibited in isolated areas** like sheepfolds, forest cantons, etc.
- Traffic controls are being intensified. According with National Disease Control Centre Decision nr.1/2019, these checks are carried out by joint teams of three institutions: IPJ (police), IJJ (gendarmes), and DSVSA (local veterinary authority).
- A well-founded risk analysis is carried out regarding the repopulation of the pig farms in order to prevent the recurrence of PPA outbreaks.

BIOSECURITY – DOMESTIC PIGS (2)

The amount for the contravention fines was increased for:

- movement of animals from restricted areas (according to CID 709/2014/EU), without sanitary - veterinary / incomplete documents,
- unidentified and unregistered animals in the National data Base,
- not announcing veterinarians / authorities regarding sick / dead animals,
- Not fulfilling game hunting quota

BIOSECURITY – WILD BOARS

- Within Romanian eradication plan of ASF in wild boars, the infected area (8km radius) is surrounded by a buffer zone of another 5km, 13km in total. Considering the increase of the incidence of ASF cases in wild boars, we are considering the possibility of extending the affected area from 13 km to 20 km.
- Based on "GF-TADs Handbook on African Swine Fever in wild boar and biosecurity during hunting", a draft on "Guide to good hunting practices and biosecurity during hunting" has been prepared. This document is being discussed with representatives of the Ministry of Waters and Forests. The final document will be sent for implementation.
- Before each hunting game, the hunters are instructed by hunting ground managers on hunting biosecurity.
- Before the activities carried out in forests (harvesting berries, mushrooms, wood cutting and such), the persons are trained by the representatives of hunting associations and forestry directorates.
- The vehicles that are used in forests and farmlands are being disinfected at exit points.

OFFICIAL CONTROLS (1)

Service note 26456 / 25.06.2019 was issued regarding checks of pig holdings that have 5 or more pigs.

During the period 02.07.2019 - 05.07.2019, the efficiency of these checks was verified, and the following non-conformities were found:

- mismatches between number of animals in the National Database and those present on the farms;
- the purchase / alienation of the pigs without compliance with the provisions of the sanitary-veterinary legislation in force, respectively without the notification of the veterinarian and without sanitaryveterinary documents;
- the slaughter of the pigs for their own consumption without the notification of the veterinarian and, implicitly, without handing over the ear tags;

OFFICIAL CONTROLS (2)

- Service note no. 26720 / 25.07.2019 regarding the carrying out of inspections according to the Delegation Agreement regarding the verification of compliance by farmers with the legal management requirements (SMR 4-9, and SMR 11-13) and the good agricultural and environmental conditions (GAEC). This action is in progress at the moment, deadline on 01.10.2019.
- In accordance with the veterinary health legislation in force, in October 2019 inspections will start on non-professional holdings. During this checks, the control measures regarding the identification and movement of pigs (in accordance with the sanitary-veterinary legislation in force) will be strengthened.
