Monitoring of the Farm to Fork Strategy

OVERARCHING OBJECTIVE – a reminder:

"The Commission (...) will monitor the transition to a sustainable food system so that it operates within planetary boundaries, including progress on the targets and overall reduction of the environmental and climate footprint of the EU food system." (F2F Strategy, final paragraph)

STARTING POINT:

- > F2F Strategy -> first sustainable food policy of the EU -> no adequate existing monitoring framework
- > Related monitoring frameworks/indicators in place -> agricultural and environmental themes (e.g. for CAP, CFP, emissions, water quality and biodiversity etc).
- Limited coverage of diet and health aspects (e.g. food consumption, health impact from diets or affordability of healthy food).
- ➤ No systemic indicators on sustainability



Monitoring of the Farm to Fork Strategy


CONCEPT

- ➤ New monitoring framework with a limited number of headline indicators
- Indicators could include, for example: monitoring progress on aspirational F2F targets, relevant SDG indicators, new indicators to cover F2F policy areas which are currently less monitored
- ➤ Indicators to cover all dimensions of sustainability (environmental, economic, social including health) and all parts of the food chain
- ➤ Operationalisation: administrative arrangements with the JRC to develop the monitoring framework
- ➤ Steering by DG SANTE in close cooperation with co-lead services for the F2F and other Commission services as needed
- > Format: interactive dashboard accessible online
- ➤ Links and synergies <-> monitoring chapter in the FSFS




Work done so far

- Development of food system approach
- Inventory of drivers along the various components of the food supply chain to highlight domains where sustainability of the food system is (likely to be) impacted
- Review of existing and relevant initiatives
- High level food system concept
- Mapping of the 3 sustainability dimensions into thematic areas, subdimensions, goals/targets
- Gathering of pool of existing indicators with potential relevance







Process: Tentative Timeline and Milestones

- > Autumn 2022: mapping, selection of headline indicators out of existing indicators, identification of gaps
- ➤ Winter 2022-2023: development of new indicators proposal
- > Spring 2023 -> consultations on the proposal for new & existing indicators to be part of the dashboard:
 - ☐ Internal Commission consultations + consultation of relevant agencies
 - consultation of the Advisory Group on Sustainability of Food Systems
 - consultation of Member States in the Expert Group On General Food Law And Sustainability Of Food Systems
- > By summer 2023: finalization of monitoring framework concept
- Second half 2023: technical development of the dashboard & publication (with available data/indicators)
