More ambitious targets

- Municipal waste:
 - 70% by 2030 (65% COM)
 - + 5% preparation for re-use
- Landfilling:
 - 5% by 2030 (10% COM)
 - by 2030 landfill only residual waste
 - municipal waste disposal target max 10% by 2030
- Packaging:
 - Overall recycling target 70 and 80% by 2025 and 2030 (65 and 75% COM)
 - Packaging material specific targets + 5%



Time extensions

- based on recycling performance in 2013 (below 20%)
- + based on landfilling performance in 2012 (above 65%)
- + approval of time extension by COM based on conditions
- + revocation of time extension if the interim target is not met



Stricter calculation rules for recycling

- Measurement point only at the "input to final recycling" (COM proposal included also "output of sorting")
- Definition of municipal waste without the quantity criterion (i.e. waste that is similar in nature and composition to household waste)
- No combined re-use and recycling target (as COM proposed)



Other new targets

- Re-use target for packaging waste 5% in 2025 and 10% in 2030
- Aspirational food waste reduction target 50% by 2030 with 2014 baseline
- Aspirational marine litter reduction target 50% by 2030 with 2014 baseline
- Waste oils regeneration 85% by 2025



Other provisions

- Obligatory EPR measures (Article 8)
- Obligatory EPR schemes for packaging waste
- Strengthened general requirements for EPR schemes (Art 8A)
- Separate collection removal of TEEP
- Separate collection extended to biowaste, textiles, hazardous household waste, waste oils
- Numerous tasks for COM (legislative proposals, delegated/implementing acts, guidance...)

- Main open issues concern: level of targets, definition of municipal waste, calculation rules for recycling and landfilling, financial coverage of EPR schemes
- Lower level of ambition on targets
- Cion proposal on food waste maintained in full
- Trilogues likely to start during MT Presidency
