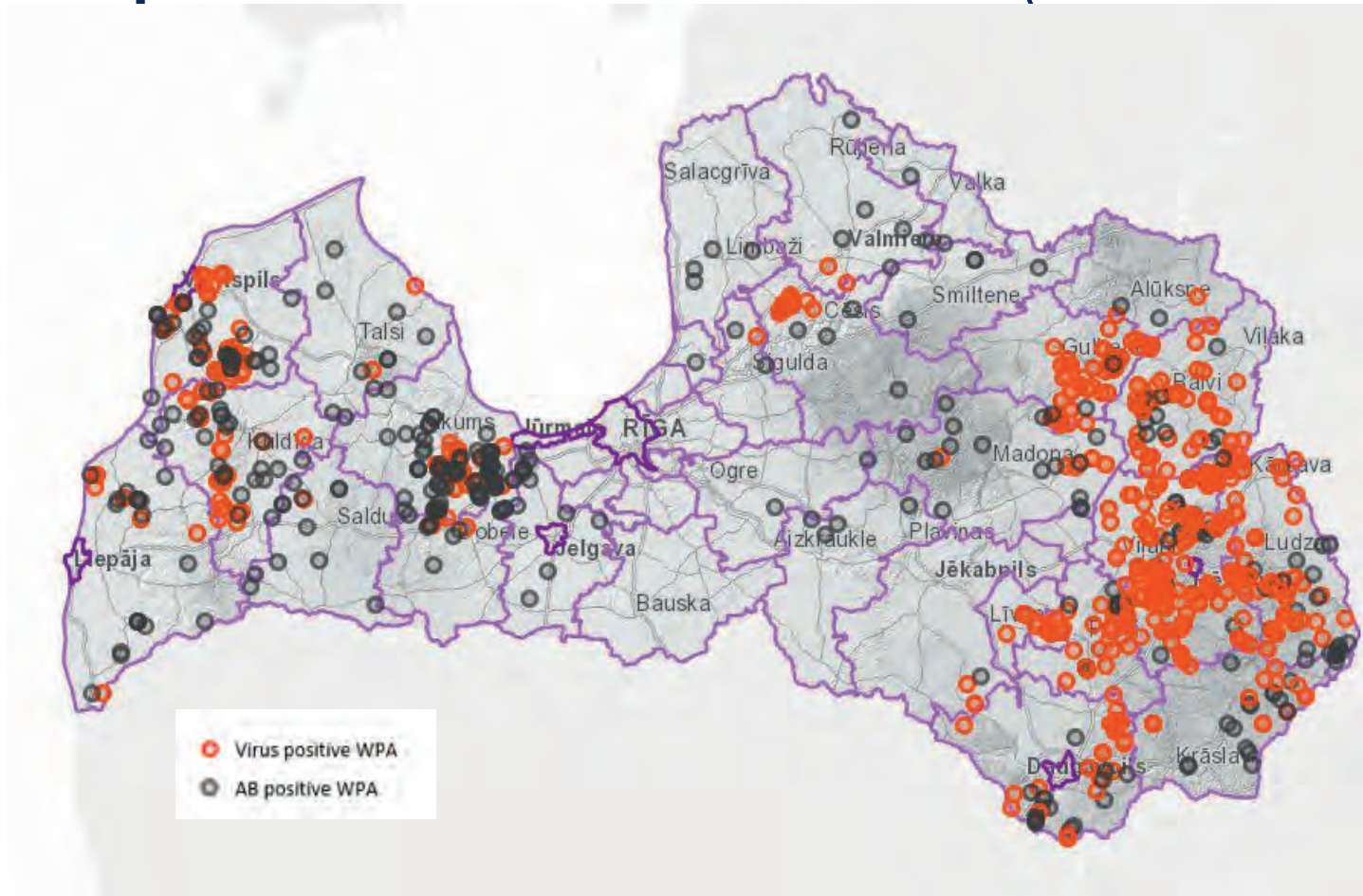
ASF epidemiological situation in Latvia – 2022 (update)

Wild porcine animals cases in 2022 (till 28th November)



Sampling and testing:

26 193 - samples from hunted wild porcine animals

755 - samples from found dead wild porcine animals

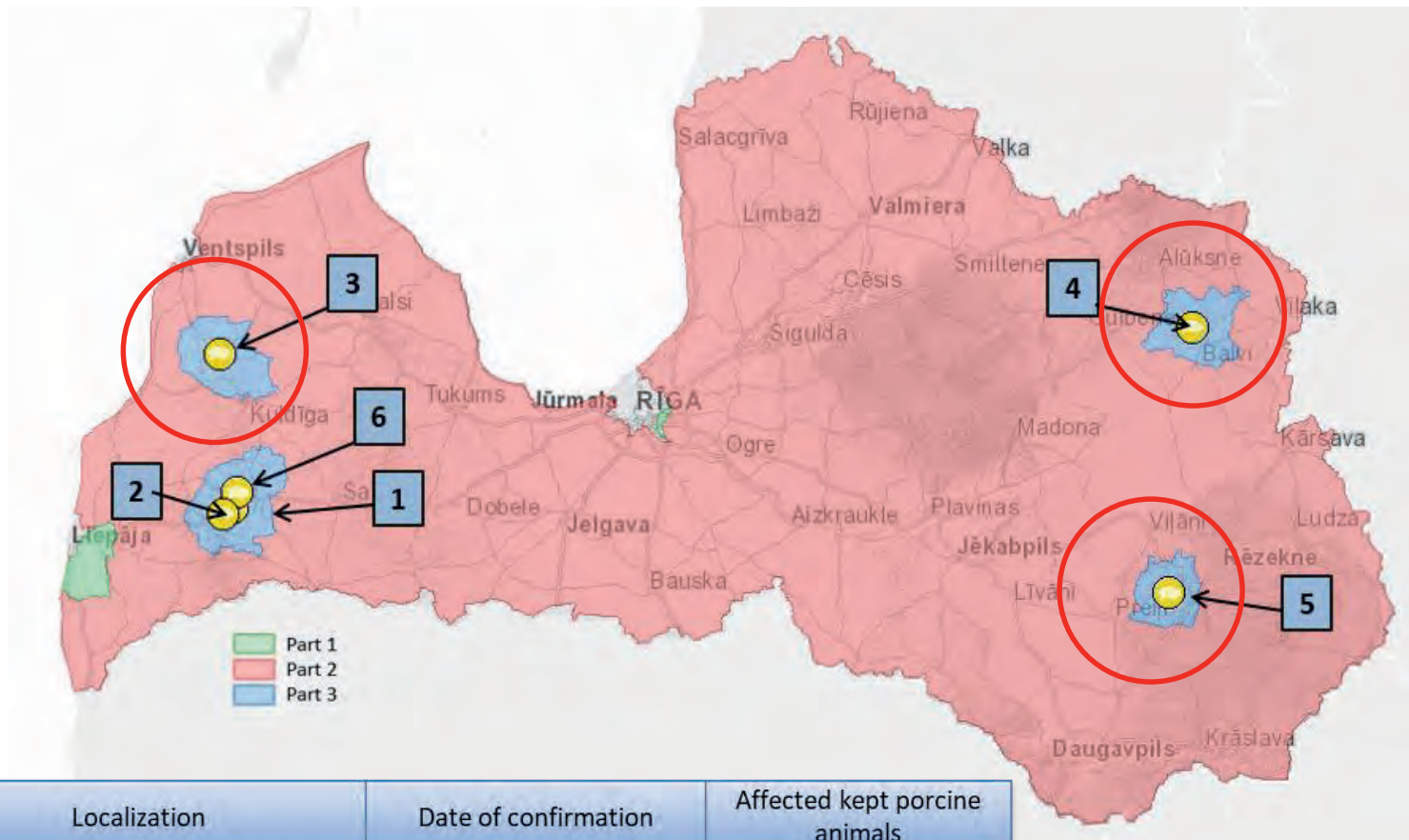
In total **1110** ASF cases in wild porcine animals (558 hunted, 552 found dead)

ASF virus positive 776 cases, seropositive 334 cases

ASF outbreaks kept porcine animals in 2022

Application for lifting certain areas of Part III

Reversion Part III to Part II in the following territories due to outbreaks :

- **Ventspils county Zlēku parish**, outbreak **2022/3**, confirmed 13.07.2022.
- **Balvu county Kubulu parish**, outbreak **2022/4**, confirmed 11.08.2022.
- **Rēzeknes county Silmalas parish**, outbreak **2022/5**, confirmed 12.08.2022.

Based on the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 and according to Commission working document No. SANTE/7112/2015:

- At least 3 months after the disinfection of the infected establishments are past;
- Clinical examinations are carried out;
- Passive surveillance system for establishments of kept porcine animals is implemented;
- Active and passive surveillance for wild porcine animals is implemented.

Application for lifting certain areas of Part III

ASF surveillance in kept porcine animals in Part III

- Clinical examinations have been carried out with favorable results
- Biosecurity checks:
 - there are 191 registered establishments
 - 71 inspections on biosecurity requirements have been carried out in 56 establishments
 - non-compliances were detected in 29 establishments, 11 cases in the establishments insignificant incompliances were identified which were rectified during the inspections, in 15 establishments repeated inspections were carried out.

ASF surveillance in wild porcine animals

Number of wild porcine animals tested to ASF in Part III (active and passive surveillance)

	2022 (July - November (data on 15th))
Dead wild porcine animals	102
Hunted wild porcine animals	486
TOTAL (positive wild porcine animals)	588 (144)
