1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

Generally, most frequent deficiencies have been detected during inspections of cattle, pigs and dogs – 9 deficiencies related to transport of cattle (e. g. documentation, fitness of animals for transport), 2 deficiencies involving pigs (documentation) and puppies (fitness of animals for transport, space allowance).

Fitness of animals for transport and space allowance have been considered as major non – compliances which may have significant impact on the welfare of animals.

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED ABOVE:

All deficiencies are addressed in accordance with valid legislation and relevant methodical instructions (sanctions imposed depending on the circumstances, veterinary measures ordered by the inspector).
