Fipronil contamination incident

- Criminal action of few individuals → threat for the entire food chain
- Collective challenge for being vigilant
- Complex food supply chains
 - need for strong and efficient control systems
 - → need for communication and cooperation at all levels
- Important role and responsibility for food business operators and their organisations



Criteria for identifying endocrine disruptors

Pesticides

- 4 July 2017: 21 MS representing 72,35% of the population endorsed criteria proposed by the Commission for the identification of endocrine disrupting active substances in pesticides
- 4 October 2017: the EP rejected these criteria; the Commission cannot adopt them and interim criteria remain in force - Commission is now reflecting on the next steps

Biocides

- 4 September 2017: Commission adopted a delegated act setting criteria for the identification of endocrine disrupting substances in biocides
- 4 November 2017: end of EP and Council scrutiny
- Mid 2018: application of the criteria for biocides



Renewal of approval for glyphosate

- Based on a thorough evaluation by the Rapporteur Member State, a peer-review by other Member States and EFSA and an opinion by ECHA on the classification of glyphosate, the Commission proposed a renewal of the approval of the substance for 10 years in July 2017
- Three rounds of discussions with Member States: on 20 July,
 5 October and 25 October
- Commission proposed an amended Regulation for renewal of approval for 5 years – no qualified majority on 9 November 2017
- Decision to be presented before the Appeals Committee next week



Fitness Check on General Food Law

-To be formally adopted by end of 2017/early 2018

-15 years Anniversary of the General Food Law, Monday 27 November 2017
