Intervention date marking

- > Part of broad approach
- Intervention to clarify date marks on food packaging using visual cues
- Best place & moment to help consumers prevent food waste



- > 2021: Consumer research by Wageningen University & Research
- > If intervention is succesful: pilots fall 2021
- Collaboration between Ministry of Agriculture, Nature and Food Quality, the Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport, Too Good To Go Netherlands and Food Waste Free United



Database sustainable food interventions

- Database with successful consumer interventions on sustainable food (including food waste) to get broader application
- > Share, review, recognise and publish succesful interventions
- Goal: change consumption pattern to more climate friendly: less pressure on climate - without limiting choice for consumers
- > Started 2021 making strategy together with potential users
- Kickstart database: position it well, stimulate use and create ownership
