BTSF: Better training for safer food

A DG SANTE **training initiative** since 2005 for EU/EEA* and non-EU official control staff, sometimes stakeholders

Objective: High levels of competence and knowledge of EU/EEA* rules leading to harmonised approach to control systems and enforcement, facilitating trade and market access

Train the Trainer Principle

Multi-lingual Training Dissemination

*EEA (European Economic Area) is made up of the 27 EU countries, plus Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway, all part of EU/EEA common internal market.

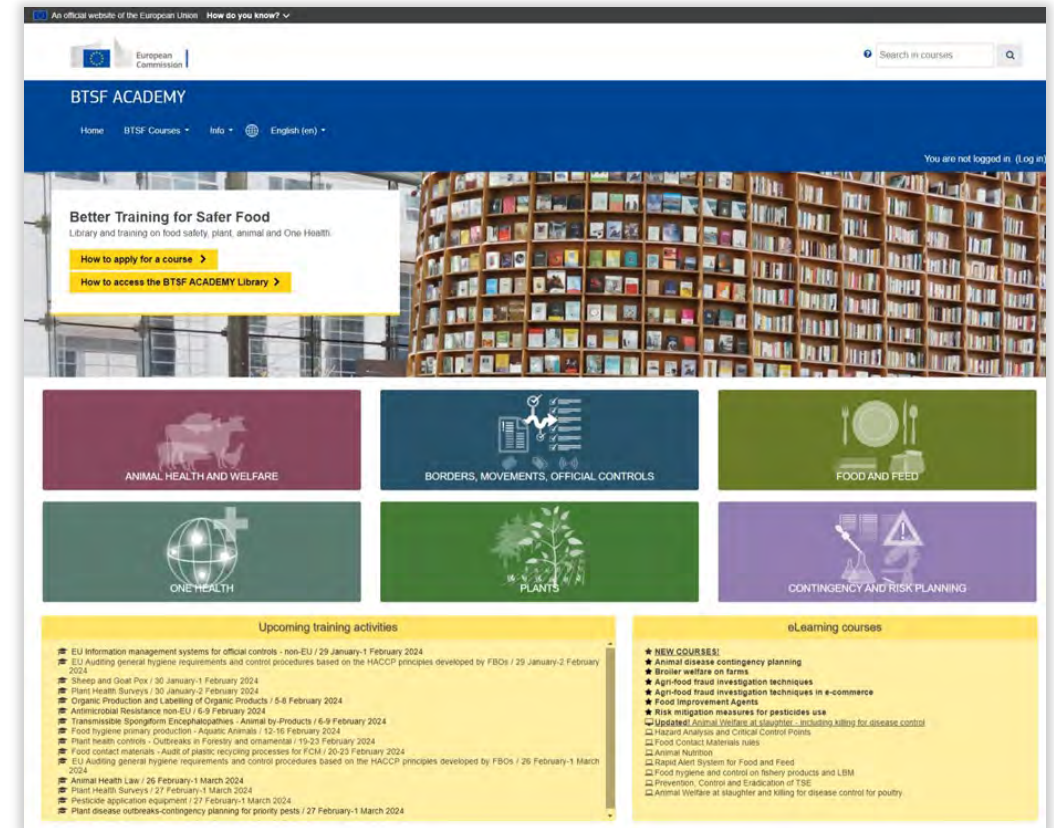

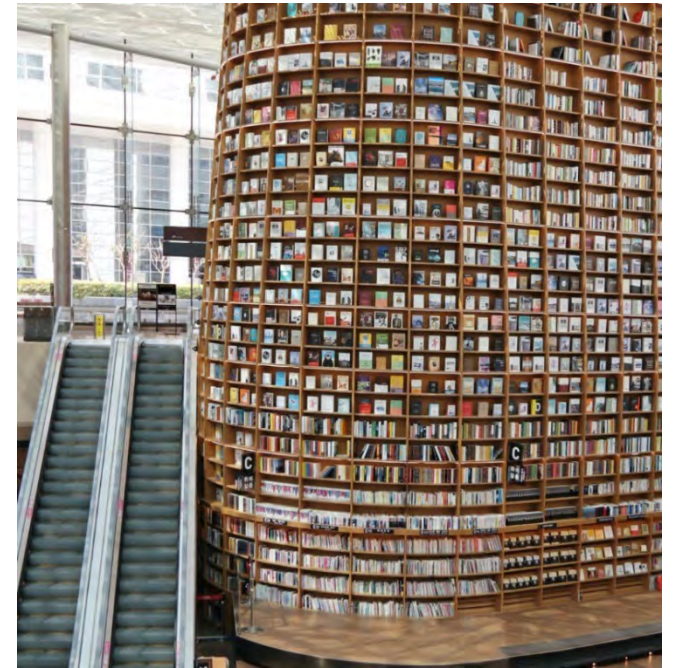
BTSF LIBRARY

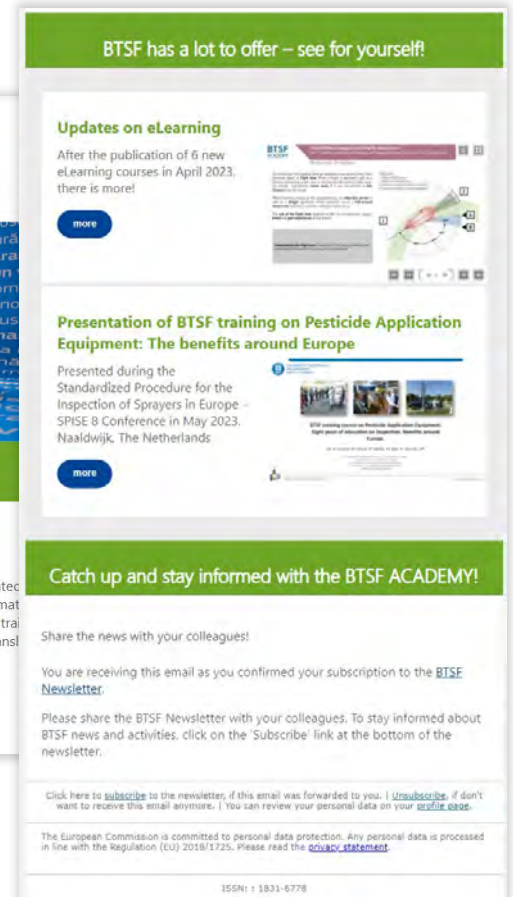

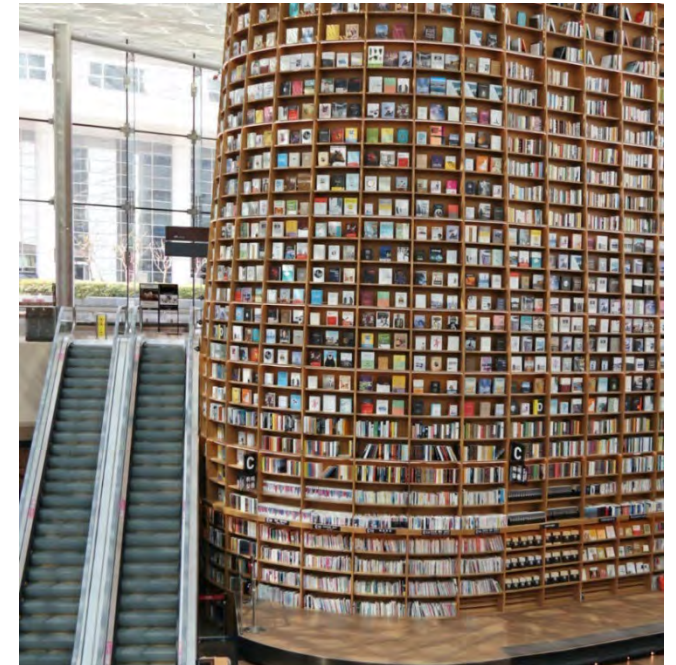
