Background



- Sweden has for many years applied a strict non-vaccination policy as regards ND; Sweden also has the status as a non-vaccinating country as regards ND according to EU legislation
- Only single outbreaks; every year
- Previous outbreaks August, October and November 2017, October 2016, July 2014;



Summary of outbreak

17/10 suspicion, sampling

23/10 confirmation of ND, restriction zones and all restrictions and necessary measures according to Directive 92/66/EEC

24/10 reporting ADNS and WAHIS (OIE)

26/10 killing of all birds.

27/10 Preliminary cleaning and disinfection

16/11 protection zone is lifted

25/11 plan lifting all restrictions



Outbreak in one herd



- <u>The herd</u>:
 A farm with 5000 free range laying hens, cattle for meat production
- *Symptoms*: eggdrop and shell-less eggs. No increased mortality.
- Killing by gas in the shed




Analysis: 57 cloacal and tracheal swabs were sent to SVA for analysis. The samples were positive(51 out of 57) in real-time PCR (L gene MGB 2). Based on the phylogenetic analysis the virus belong to the genotype VIa.

Analysis: Organ samples from 10 birds euthanized at the farm (26/10) were used for virus isolation attempt. The virus isolation attempt is currently ongoing (passage two of three)







Measures and Information

- Protection zone (3 km) and surveillance zone (10 km)
 Stamping out, disposal of dead animals and products, cleaning and disinfection
 tracing and recalling of products
- No movement of live poultry, hatching eggs and not-heated poultry products from restriction area
- No export of live poultry, hatching eggs and non-heated poultry products from 4 municipalities (Mölndal, Kungsbacka, Göteborg and Härryda)
- All hobby herds in restriction area are contacted
