# Italian SVD status (updated to September 2017)

According to Dec. 2005/779/CE <u>Italy is a</u> <u>SVD free country</u> except for Campania and Calabria regions.

Dec. 2005/779/CE (art. 5-6), reinforced by national rules




# **SVD eradication programme in Campania**

#### **N. ANIMALS CONTROLLED**






## **SVD** eradication programme in Campania




- After 2011 epidemic, the Campania Region carried out an extra-ordinary eradication program. Additional measures implemented were:
  - Increased biosecurity measures and closure of non compliant holdings
  - Increased controls on pig movements
  - Stamping out, without compensation, of unidentified pigs



### **SVD eradication programme in Campania**





- -Last SVD outbreak in Campania Region notified on 27 Oct. 2014.
- -Epidemiological investigation following the detection of last seropositive pigs in 2015.
- -No SVD seropositive pigs detected in 2016 and 2017.



## **Recognition of Campania as SVD-Free Region**



Since the end of 2015 the 100% of pig holdings are recognized as free from swine vesicular disease.

Based on this results Italy requests the recognition of SVD-Free status for Campania Region, with the amendment of Annexes I and II to Decision 2005/779/EC.
