Slovenia's annual report for 2012
on the inspections of animals, means of transport and accompanying documents,
pursuant to art. 27 of the Regulation 1/2005/EC

We are sending you the annual report as required in article 27 of Regulation 1/2005/EC.

Analysis:

Total number of transported animals in Slovenia in 2012 is comparable to the numbers in the year 2011. There is an increase in total number of pigs transported, mostly due to the increase of »other animals transported« (line d). Line d includes mostly animals in tranzit through Slovenia. Information on this figure comes exclusively from TRACES database, which is not a reliable source of this information, as entering transit member states is not mandatory when completing Traces certificate.

Total number of road side inspections, and total number of infringements discovered decreased in 2012 compared to 2011. This can be explained by downsizeing of the mobile unit which is in charge of official control of transport by road.

On the other hand there is an increase of inspections performed at place of departure, which is in line with last year's action plan. No infringements were found during these inspections.

Action plan:

Most important change envisaged for the following year is introduction of new system of data collection for annual report on official report in compliance with Commission Implementing Decision 2013/188/EU of 18 April 2013.
