1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

- 1.1. Non-realistic journey plans for long distance journeys waiting times on borders to third countries- time to final destination;
- 1.2. Not sufficient condition of some animals (not fit for transport-lameness);
- 1.3. Absence of original documents on board of vehicle;

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

- 2.1. On meetings with local level officials is pointed out, that allways they must control journey plans before loading of animals with relevant websites (Google maps, Via Michelin), central level worked out new version of instruction for regional level.
- 2.2. Local officials are once again trained how to assess animals condition before loading. Also control is the amount of litter and drinking water is proportional with length of journey.
- 2.3. To some transporters was applied prescriptions for technical condition of vehicle (termometers and navigation systems).
