

Conditions of trade relating to bluetongue for cattle, sheep and goats destined for France from a Member State or a zone not free from bluetongue from 21st April 2021

I. Animals over 70 days of age

Must be vaccinated against all bluetongue virus serotypes reported within the last two years in the Member State or zone of origin.

The movements will take place **at least 30 days after the injection of the primary series** (if the vaccine used requires a single injection); **or 10 days (if the vaccine used requires 2 injections)**, in accordance with Annex V, part II, chapter 2 section 1, paragraph 7 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/689, of 17 December 2019, supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the rules applicable to surveillance, to programs of eradication and to the “free” status of certain listed and emerging diseases.

II. Animals under 70 days of age

The animal:

- a. Come from a vaccinated mother against all serotypes of the bluetongue virus declared during the last two years in the Member State or zone of origin (in accordance with Annex V, part II, chapter 2, section 1, paragraph 7, of Regulation 2020/689).

OR

- b. Is protected against vector attacks by insecticides or repellents for at least 14 days preceding the date of movement;

AND

Subjected during this period to a PCR with a negative result, carried out on blood samples taken at least 14 days after the date of onset of protection against vector attacks (In accordance with Annex V part II chapter 2, section 1, paragraph 6 of Regulation 2020/689).
