What are EU import conditions? A reminder

- Guarantees to be provided as regards products of animal origin by:
 - Listing of countries or regions: assurances at national or regional level

Reliable control system Animal health

- Listing of establishments: assurances at establishment level: e.g. compliance with hygiene rules
- Certification: assurances at consignment level



Three draft Regulations under discussion:

- 1. Delegated Regulation under Article 126(1)
- 2. Implementing Regulation under Article 127(2): List of countries
- 3. Implementing Regulation under Article 90: model certificates

Obligation to refer to CN codes



Consultations so far

9 June 2017 and 6 October 2017: short presentation to the MS

8 November 2017: Ad-hoc consultation meeting with Advisory Group for the Food Chain

18-19 January 2018: detailed discussion with Member States

Bilateral exchanges with Member States and European stakeholders' organizations



1. Delegated Regulation under Article 126(1)

- Food requiring listing of third countries and conditions for such listing
- Food requiring listing of establishments and conditions for such listing
- Food requiring certification
- Specific conditions
 - fresh meat, minced meat, meat preparations, meat products and MSM
 - LBM, echinoderms, tunicates and marine gastropods
 - fishery products



1. Delegated Regulation under Article 126(1): Main issues discussed

- Link with Article 47 (BIP checks) in particular for sprouts and seeds intended for sprouting
- Some reluctance on the derogation from the listing of establishments for highly refined products
- Shorter consultation period for updating lists of establishments proposed



2. Implementing Regulation listing countries and regions (Art 127(2))

- Mandatory for **all products of animal origin** by the end of 2020, including insects, reptile meat, ... or import would no longer be allowed
- Main comments were on the consideration of live snails, insects (dead and alive), casings



3. Implementing Regulation laying down model certificates/documents (Art 90): main comments

- Technical comments related to consistency of wordings, insects, snails, reptile meat
- Need and legal basis to include the certificates for ante-mortem inspection at the holding + role of signing veterinarian



Ongoing

- Internal reflections on import conditions for composite products
- Internal clarification on insects:
 - Dead ones, parts and processed ones: novel food
 - Live insects: not novel food
- Internal consultation of TAXUD (CN-codes) and the Legal Service
- Questionnaire collecting information on lists of countries and establishments for insects, reptile meat, casings and highly refined products
