71 kilo per inhabitant




19,2% of population lives in risk of poverty






## Food waste in Croatia data from 2020.

## Plan for the prevention and reduction of food waste of the Republic of Croatia 2023-2028

- improving the food donation system
- encouraging the reduction of food waste
- promoting social responsibility of the food sector
- raising consumer awareness
- education of preschool and school-age children
- measuring of food waste
- investing in research work and innovative solutions to prevent food waste





## Strategic framework

#### **National Recovery and Resilience Plan 2021-2026**

Reform measure "Advancement of food donation system in Croatia"

- 1) infrastructural equipping of food donation intermediars and food bank
- 2) digitalisation of food donation systems
- 3) educational campaigns
- 4) voluntary agreement for the prevention of food waste

Financial value: 4,2 million euros

Implementation period: 2021-2023









## Infrastructural equipping of food donation intermediars and food bank

- The Support Scheme has been put in operation following a public call and contracts concluded
- 50 grant beneficiaries (charity organizations)
- Eligible costs:
  - construction and refurbishment of storage facilities
  - storage equipment and furniture
  - cooling and food storage equipment
  - fork-lift trucks
  - refrigerated vehicles
  - vehicles
  - IT equipment.







## Infrastructural equipping of food donation intermediaries and food bank

#### **Food banks**

- 9 beneficiaries
- 955.604 EUR

#### **Food donation intermediaries**

- 41 beneficiaries
- 991.473 EUR

Total: 1,9 millions of euros 2021-2023



### Individual goals of the signatories



- conclusion of cooperation agreements with food bank and/or intermediaries in the food donation chain
- raising awareness, informing and educating consumers
- establishment of system for measuring and monitoring of food waste
- optimizing of the reuse of inevitably created surplus food
- the use of innovative ways of production, storage, preservation and packaging of food
- improvement of internal processes for food handling (procurement, storage, processing, packaging, transport)
- education and training of employees......





### Lessons learned

- The Recovery and Resilience Facility is a good instrument that can be used for financeing of projects related to food donation and food waste
- The disadvantage is that the instrument cannot finance labor costs
- It is necessary to ensure enough human capacity for the necessary project administration
