

Wild birds


Evolution: September and October in wild birds

Low number of cases (H5N1) in September and October 2022.




Situation in wild birds

Poultry:


Period of time	Number of outbreaks	
active outbreaks on 20.10.2022 :	19	
from 14.9.2022 (last PAFF) until 20.10.2022:	19	
from 15.7.2022 until 20.10.2022:	35 (16 lifted)	

Captive birds:

• One active outbreak: Zoo




Evolution: Poultry and captive birds






Active outbreaks in poultry: 19.

Outbreak in a trade establishment

Outbreak DE-HPAI(P)-2022-00065

Administrative divisions:

Level 1: Nordrhein-Westfalen

Level 2: Gütersloh

Breeding and trader establishment with a flock of 8.580 poultry:

- ducks: breeding and fattening,
- geese: young and fattening,
- hens: young and fattening.
- Two houses: symptoms just in one of them.



Affected species

Outbreak in a trade establishment Measures

- **14**.10.2022 suspicion
- **15**.10.2022 confirmation outbreak
- **15**.10.2022 killing
 - electro-water bath
 - Argon-/Co2 gas
- 16.10.2022 preliminary cleaning and disinfection officially completed



Epidemiological enquiry


Epidemiological enguiry: still going on (21 days before the suspicion)

Contact establishments in 10 Länder BB, BW, BY, HE, MV, NW, SN, ST, SH, TH.


and 4 Member States: AT, BE, DK, NL.

Ms: Have been informed without undue delay and kept

updated.







Summary

Summary

- Epidemiological situation in wild-birds and poultry still similar to the situation during summer.
- Epidemiologically no obvious evidence by now that infected migratory birds returned to Germany.
- The control of the particular event caused by the trader establishment is on-going.
