Work programme for the European Union Reference Laboratory for Feed Additives (EURL-FA) – Control, 2015

Overview on major objectives for the period January – December 2015

Important note: The EURL-FA is operated under two legal frames, namely under Regulation EC (No) 1831/2003 (authorisation activities) and under Regulation EC (No) 882/2004 (control activities). The work programme proposed here applies exclusively to the control activities.

In 2015, the EURL-FA Control will continue aiming at contributing to the general objective of the European Commission as regards the contribution to a high level of health for humans and animals, ensuring a high level of protection as described in the Annex to the Commission Implementing Decision *establishing the work programme for the year 2015 on financial contribution to the European Union Reference Laboratories*. Our proposed objectives for 2015 are to contribute to the

- 1. Specific Objective : to contribute to a high level of safety of food/feed and food/feed production and a higher animal health status;
- 2. Specific Objective: to improve effectiveness, efficiency and reliability of official controls.

and to the

- 3. Operational Objective 1: To ensure the development and use of high quality analytical methods across the EU-RL framework
 - a. ensuring dissemination of analytical and reference methods from EU-RLs to NRLs;
- 4. Operational Objective 2: To maintain appropriate level of proficiency testing ensuring efficiency of control analysis methods
 - a. ensuring planning and initiation of comparative testing by EU-RLs in accordance with internationally accepted protocols;
 - b. address underperforming related issues within the EU-RL network;

- 1. Organising a proficiency test for the determination of carotenoids in feedingstuffs (Deadline: October 2015) and report on the organisation and outcome of the mentioned collaborative trial (Deadline: November 2015).
- 2. Organising of the fourth workshop of the EURL for Feed Additives Control with participation of National Reference Laboratories and report on this activity and its outcome (Deadline December 2015).
- 3. Setting up and maintaining a web-based discussion forum for the EURL and the NRL's, in order to share information and to foster discussions between the laboratories on relevant topics
- 4. Organising a follow-up survey with the underperforming National reference Laboratories in the frame of the proficiency testing exercise on coccidiostats 2014 (Deadline: August 2015).
- 5. Providing support to standardisation bodies such as CEN for the standardisation of analytical methods for the determination of feed additives. This will require a regular participation in the meetings of CEN TC 327/WG3.
- 6. Representing the EURL and dissemination of information concerning the EURL activities at international conferences and national associations of official laboratories such as VDLUFA.
- 7. Providing support to DG SANCO in technical matters concerning analytical methodology for the determination of feed additives analysis, if requested.
- 8. Conducting a study to identify and solve problems in respect to the implementation of specific Community methods for the determination of coccidiostats, based on corresponding information provided by some NRLs.
