A.01 Guide on Good Hygiene Practices for producers of insects as food & feed. (IPIFF)

The Guide covers the production of insects destined for human consumption or animal feed (i.e. including feed for food producing animals, pet food and fur animals) and encompasses all production steps, from the feeding of the insects, their breeding, the killing and other processing steps, storage, transport or retail activities, to the final delivery of the product to consumers, feed manufacturers or farmers.

A.02 Sharing good practices in slaughter hygiene guidance. (UECBV)

The European slaughterhouse industry, represented by UECBV, has decided to share some of the good practices in slaughter hygiene that are currently employed effectively in some EU slaughterhouses. This guidance document focuses on preventing and minimising contamination of fresh meat with faecal or ingesta material during slaughter by effective means.

A.03 Presentation and possible endorsement of the EURL Guidelines for the evaluation of new methods, reagents and apparatuses for the detection of *Trichinella* larvae in meat intended for human consumption. (KDS)

The draft aims at adjusting the official laboratory method for the detection of insect particles in feed, in the context of the official control of the implementation of the feed ban provisions.

It establishes a permanent framework, and where necessary restrictions or prohibitions, for the control of movements of live cervids in and from the affected countries, as well as of the intra-EU trade and import of cervid urine hunting lures.
