




### **Situation of SGPV in Spain**



PROVINCE	OUTBREAKS	AFFECTED CENSUS
Granada	12	2,978 sheep + 158 goats
Almería	1	97 sheep + 9 goats
Cuenca	13	34,835 sheep + 338 goats
Ciudad Real	4	13,868 sheep + 260 goats




Total affected census: 51,778 sheep & 767 goats.



# Outbreak 2023/7 in Cuenca


- On 17/05/2023, notification of a new outbreak in the municipality of Casas de Fernando Alonso, in the province of Cuenca.
- One month without (last outbreaks 28/03/2023 and 10/04/2023 in Ciudad Real, 60 km), and after almost four months of the last outbreaks in Cuenca (La Alberca de Záncara and Tébar, 20 km).





# Outbreak 2023/7 in Cuenca

- Medium-sized milk production farm (334 sheep and 27 goats).
- Communication by the farmer to SVO on May 15<sup>th</sup>, with immediate immobilization of the farm.
- Delay in notification of the suspicious, with 21 symptomatic sheep on May 15<sup>th</sup>.





#### **Detection of skin lesions**

- Communication of the **detection of skin lesions** by the farmer to OVS.
- Several sheep with old healed lesions:
  late notification of symptoms.
- On May 15th (visit of OVS): detection of **21** clinically affected sheep.
- At the moment of culling: at least 40 affected animals.











### **Epidemiological investigation**

- So far, non conclusive results of the epidemiological investigation.
- However, it is suspected that the **farmer have moved animals** without authorization to a fattening holding in the area (non-documented movements) → Investigation under progress, in order to detect further ilegalities and implement fines. Fattening holding visited and inspected by OVS (tested negative by PCR).
- Truck of milk and feed does not enter the holding, though driver may enter to collaborate in these operations.
- Age of lesions: at least one month.



#### **Enhanced control measures in CLM**

- Maintenance of the Further Restricted Zone (FRZ) to the entire territory of Castilla La Mancha, except for the province of Guadalajara, applicable until 13st July.
- Movements only to slaughterhouses only within zones (PZ-PZ; SZ-SZ) and from FRZ to free zone.
- Before these movements: clinical inspection of animals to be moved at least 24 hours before + check of C&D conditions of vehicles + sealing of trucks.
- Enhancement of biosecurity. C&D controls in slaughterhouses.
- Enhanced active surveillance, with official visit, clinical inspection and sampling of salivary swabs (2% prevalence, 95% confidence) in all those farms with any epi link with detected outbreaks.
- Enhanced ante and post-mortem inspection in SH operating in the areas.





#### **Enhanced control measures in CLM**

- Awareness: meetings of the OVS with farmers and sheep and goat sector associations in different Municipalities of Castilla La Mancha, aimed at increasing awareness on the disease, biosecurity and passive surveillance → Important Media coverage of the meetings at regional and national level.
- Intensification of collaboration with SEPRONA and road police (increase the presence in the area, road controls on animal movements vehicles, controls on C&D of vehicles, etc.).



24-26/05/2023: **Mission from experts from the EU-VET team** to Castilla – La Mancha.





### Conclusions

- Detection of **new outbreak** (2023/7) in the municipality of Casas de Fernando Alonso, in the province of Cuenca in Castilla La Mancha.
- Detection after more than a month since last outbreak and more than 4 months after latest outbreaks in Cuenca (la Alberca de Záncara, Tébar).
- **Delay in communication by the farmer to the OVS**. Lesions older than on month (How long time?).
- Non-conclusive epidemiological investigation.
- Conclusions and recommendations from the **EU-VET team expert mission**.
