1	9:30-10:00	Exchange of views on a draft Commission Delegated Regulation amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2123 as regards the conditions for issuance of the separate Common Health Entry Document (CHED) in cases when consignments leave the border control post to the control point for identity and physical checks	The Commission presented the draft Regulation amending Regulation (EU) 2019/2123. The purpose of this amendment is to establish the link between the initial CHED, referred to in Article 2(1)(a), and the separate CHED, referred to in Article 2(1)(d) of that Regulation, and to ensure traceability for consignments transferred to CP other than BCP for identity and physical checks. The Member States raised questions about the issuance of CHED D, and the possibility for the control point to accept or reject the transfer of the consignment. They also raised a technical issue regarding the receipt of confirmation of arrival within 15 days. A Member State asked for an implementation period. The Commission provided clarifications to the questions raised by the Member States. Member States are asked to provide comments to the draft Regulation by 6 September 2024.
