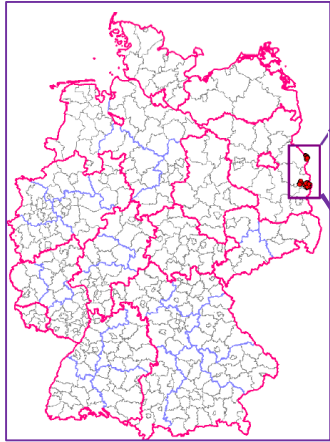

 No cases in domestic pigs!

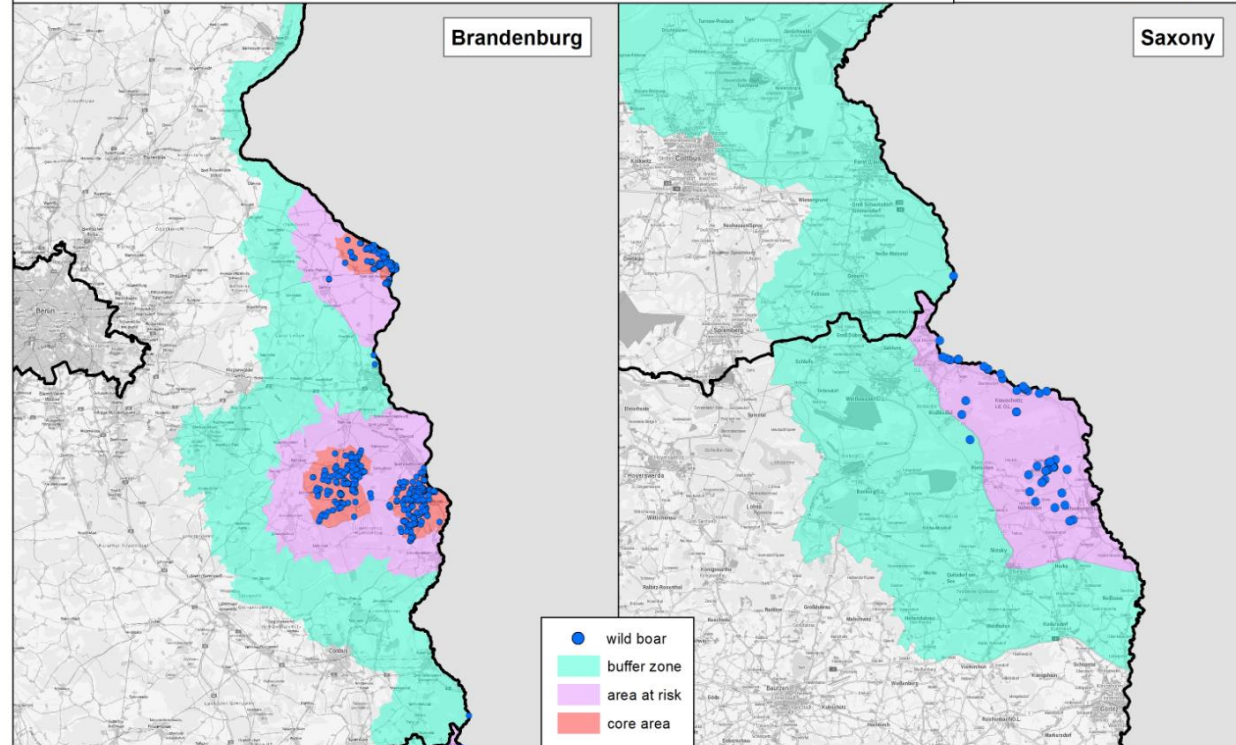

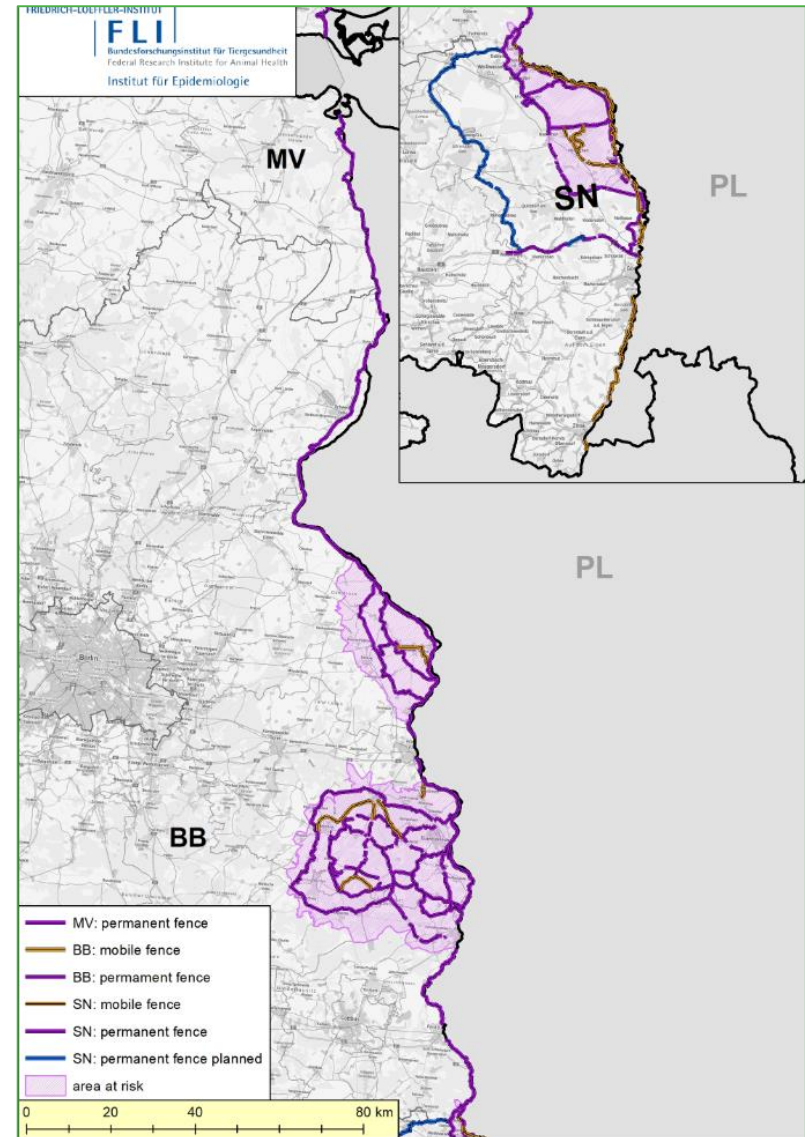
Fences

 - ~ 77 km permanent fence

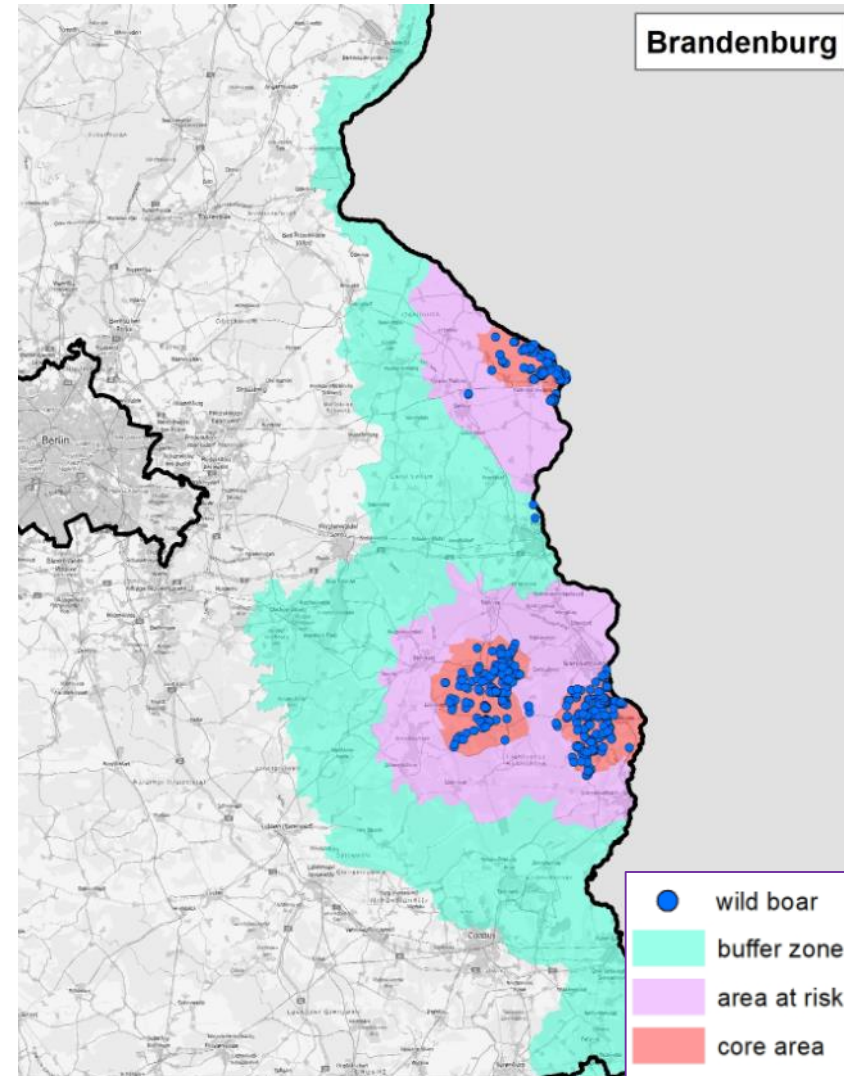
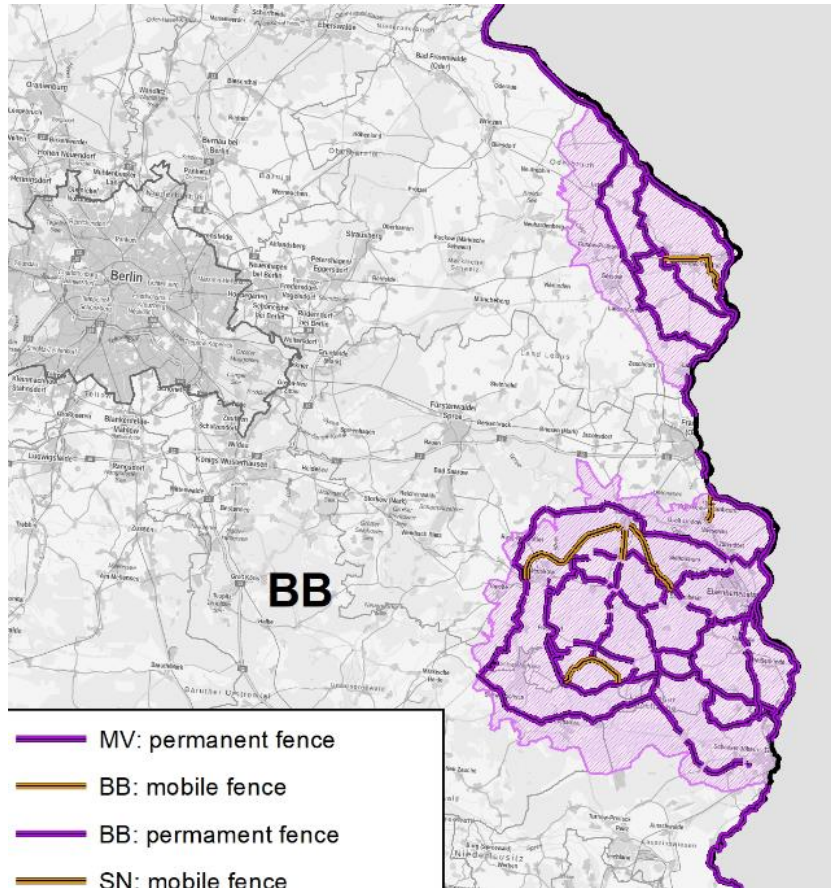
