CSF eradication program

According to Article 16, Council Directive 2001/89/EC:

- 1. CSF eradication plan was approved with the EC Decision 2013/90/EU
- 2. Emergency vaccinations plan was approved with the EC Decision 2013/91/EU

Infected and risk areas form a buffer zone to ensure decrease of spreading of CSF to the other parts of Latvia and to other Member States.



CSF surveillance – domestic pigs

During 2016 in the frame work of the surveillance program were tested 4141 domestic pigs

Number of clinical examined holdings	Sampled animals	Positive samples
660	4141	0

Submitted costs for domestic pig sampling – 2 277,55 EUR

Last CSF outbreak in June 2014.



CSF surveillance – wild boar

During 2016 in the frame work of the surveillance program were tested 4343 wild boar

	tested	PCR (field virus) positive
Active (hunted)	4090	0
Passive (found dead)	253	0

Sampling of wild boar were performed in the framework of ASF program.

Last wild boar case were found in March 2015




CSF vaccination in wild boars in Latvia

CSF vaccination were not performed during the 2016 due to the technical problems on the production side of vaccine producing company.

After the evaluation of epidemiological situation (last case in wild boar – March 2015, last outbreak in domestic pigs – June 2014) the CSF expert group took a decision to stop the vaccination of wild boar.

Serological examinations and virological tests were performed in all age classes.

Number of tested seropositive animals decreasing = no field virus present in population.





Laboratory tests

During 2016 performed:

- \checkmark 8220 − ELISA tests
- \checkmark 4068 RT-PCR tests

Submitted LAB costs – 105 154.3 EUR

Total submitted costs for the CSF co-financed program for the 2016 are **107 431,85** EUR
