



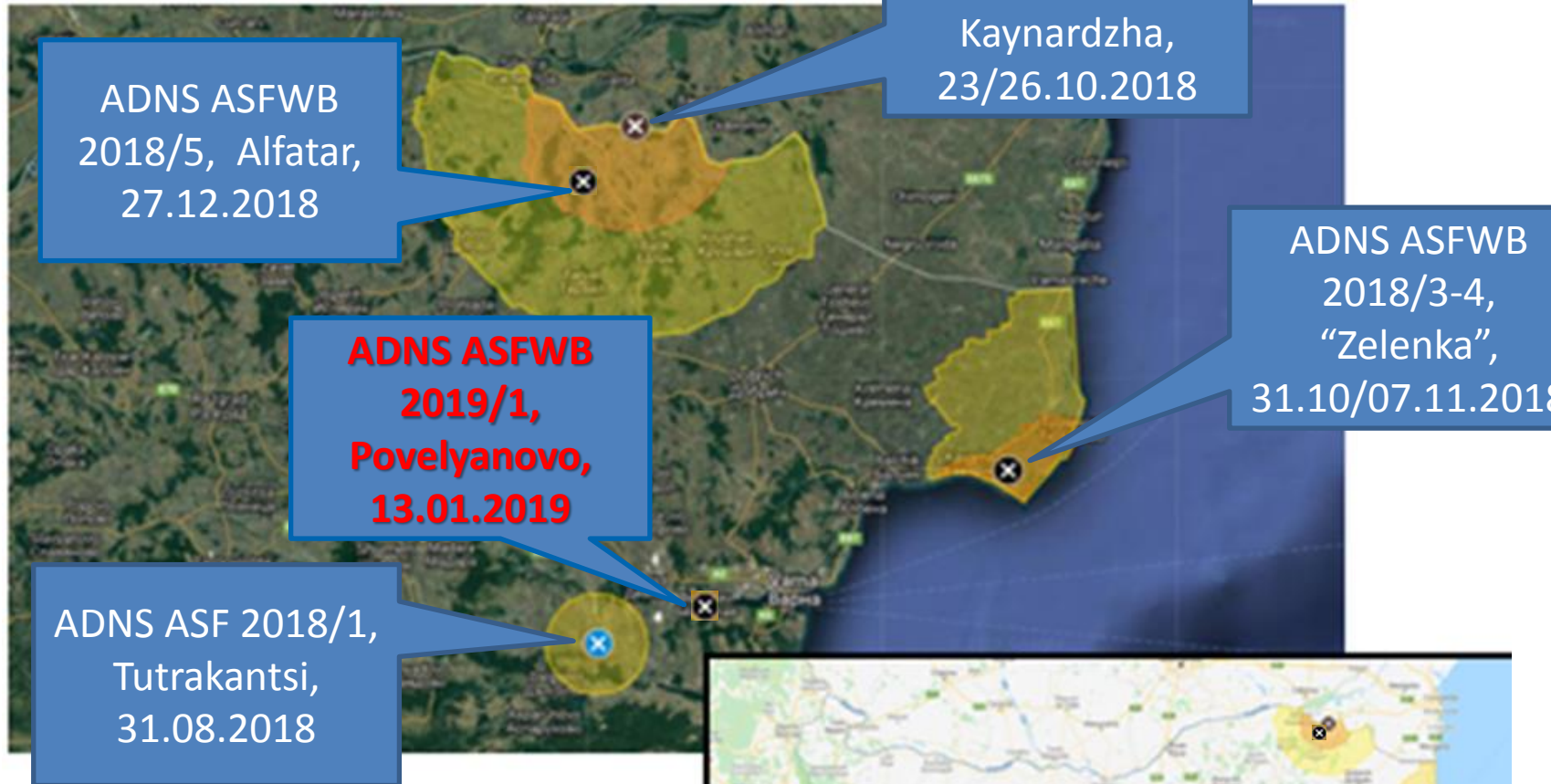

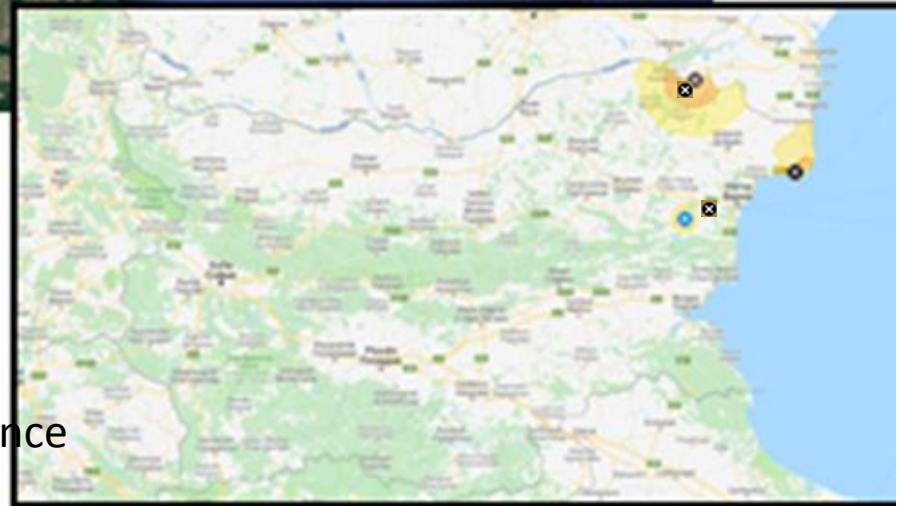
Overview of the epi-situation



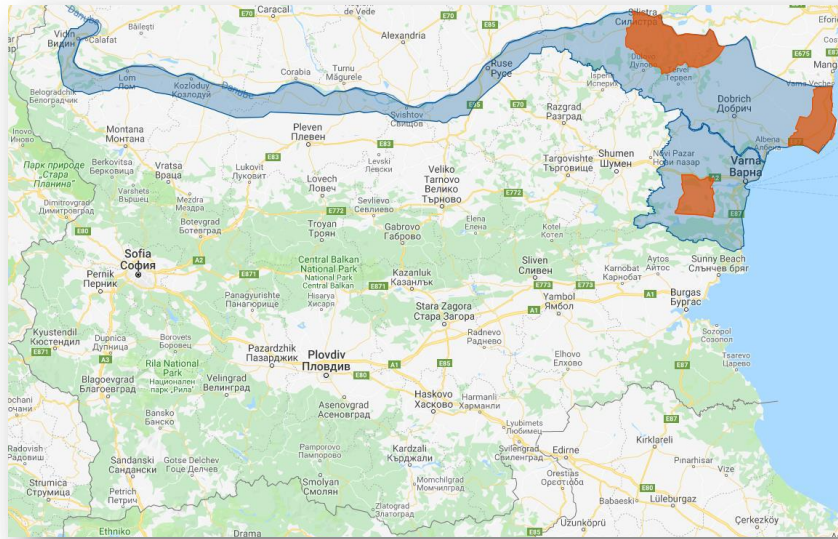
Infected zone

ASF in WB – Povelyanovo, Devnya, Varna region



13.02.2019 - ASF in WB found dead in “Phasanria” area, Povelyanovo, Devnya municipality, Varna region

Restrictive zones established:

- Infected zone of 20 km radius around the case
- Buffer zone – merged with buffer zones of Dobrich and Silistra region

Passive surveillance in domestic pig holdings – 180 samples – all negative

Surveillance in WB

Region	No of samples	Result
Varna	600 (3 passive surveillance)	1 positive (passive)

Additional national measures on surveillance

- Additional health guarantees for movements from part I and part II to South regions of BG
- Notification and approval including for movements of part I by CA
- Intensified passive surveillance in all industrial and type A farms (obligation to send samples on a regular basis from dead pigs)
