CSF monitoring program 2013

- CSF monitoring program
 - Monitoring program in domestic pig population
 - Monitoring for large pig farms
 - Monitoring program for other pig holdings
 - Monitoring in wild boar population

Monitoring in domestic pig population

- Monitoring program for large pig farms (4)
 - 25 blood samples breeding sows each quarter
 - 10 blood samples fattening pigs each quarter

Monitoring program in domestic pig population


- Monitoring programme for pig holdings
 - Herd based sampling scheme to detect a 1% level of sero-positive herds with 95% confidence (149 pig herds) combined with the risk based approach
 - sampling in breeding herds
 - sampling in small breeding herds
 - investigation of fallen stock collected by VHS (Veterinary Hygienic Service) in regional units of NVI
 - Detection of within-herd prevalence of 5% with 95% confidence in breeding herds, also combined with risk based components
 - purchased breeding pigs
 - pigs with health problems

Monitoring program in wild boar population

- Monitoring program in wildboar population
 - Random sampling: 406
 - Risk-based
 - found dead wild boars and road-kills
 - all (as much as possible) samples of wild boar shot along the border with Croatia


Results of 2013 CSF monitoring programme

- Monitoring in domestic pig population
 - 329 holdings tested
 - Testing of large pig farms and randomly selected farms (ELISA)
 - 154 holdings /3.435 samples
 - All negative
 - Testing of fallen stock (PCR)
 - 179 holdings /273 samples
 - All negative



Results of 2013 CSF monitoring programme

- Monitoring in wild boar population
 - 518 samples taken
 - Random sampling
 - 406 samples
 - Risk-based samples
 - 91 samples from risk area
 - 21 samples fallen stock (PCR)
 - all negative



Financial aspect

- Targets set in the approved programme for year
 2013 were achieved
- Commission Decisions 2012/761/EU, 2013/403/EU and 2013/766/EU;
 - approved 30.000 €
 - eligible costs 15.006, 50 €
