

Working together to tackle food waste in the EU: update on key initiatives

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Fighting Food Waste: key challenges for the Commission

Ensure that:

- prevention of food waste does not jeopardise food safety
- all actors are involved, from farm to fork
- EU action complements/adds value to Member State initiatives
- learning and best practice is shared effectively, including international experience





Fight Food Waste: no impact on safety of the food chain

- Measure and monitor progress in reducing food waste
- Facilitate food donations
- Optimise use of resources in the food and feed chain
- Promote better understanding and use of date marking

Food Waste Reduction: Regulatory initiatives

- Communication on the Circular Economy / proposal to review waste targets COM(2014)387final – 2 July 2014
- Calls on Member States to develop national food waste prevention strategies
- Non-binding target: 30% reduction by 2025
 - <u>Sectors</u>: manufacturing, retail/distribution, food service/hospitality and households (excluding agricultural production for purpose of target setting)
- Food waste definition: for setting objectives/monitoring
 - "food waste" means food (including inedible parts) lost from the food supply chain, <u>not including</u> food diverted to material uses such as bio-based products, animal feed or sent for redistribution




Food Waste: definitions & measurement

- Need for common definition to help inform food waste discussions, action and policy making (FUSIONS, July 2014)
- Need to define common framework for measuring/quantifying food waste, data collection, analysis and reporting
- Clarify resource flows in the food system
- Support effective implementation of food waste/"food use" hierarchy
 - ⇒ Supported by EU-funded FUSIONS project

Facilitate food donations

- Simplify without compromising food safety rules which apply when retailers provide food to food banks (in progress)
- Consider opportunity for EU-wide food donation guidelines for food donors and food banks eg:
 - Roles & responsibilities (food safety, hygiene, traceability...)
 - VAT regime and food donations...
 - ⇒ Ad-hoc meeting with stakeholders (28.10.2014) confirms value of guidelines/initial scoping of content
 - ⇒ Outcomes of EESC study will inform process
 - ⇒ New section on Commission website –food donation guidelines in Member States (your contributions are welcome!)



Date marking

- Consider opportunities to simplify date labelling rules:
 - Possible extension of list of products exempt from date marking ("best before" date)?
 - Consider terminology issues (eg "best before")
 - ⇒ Pursue discussions with Member States and stakeholders
- Pursue dialogue with industry regarding:
 - Consistency of practices regarding date marking?
 - Potential to reduce food waste by maximising shelf-life?
- Assess/address information needs (consumers and other actors)

 - ⇒ Pursue dialogue with interested stakeholders and with Member States


