Section A <u>Information and/or discussion</u>

A.01 Information on import of colostrum products derived from the EU Member States and processed in third countries. (MK)

Third countries which are authorised for the import of raw milk may import colostrum from the EU Member States that are recognised as free of TBC, Brucellosis and EBL and process it into colostrum products intended for the feeding of farmed animals. Third country should ensure that the colostrum derived from the EU Member States should not be mixed with the colostrum that does not comply with the same animal health standards.

Procedure: Examination procedure

B.02 Exchange of views and possible opinion of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Decision extending the period of application of Commission Decision 2008/866/EC which introduces emergency measures suspending imports from Peru of certain bivalve molluscs intended for human consumption. (SPM)

The draft Commission Implementing Decision proposes extending its period of application until 30 November 2017. The protective measures need to be extended

until the effectiveness of the corrective measures taken by the Peruvian competent authorities has been demonstrated. To date the Commission cannot conclude that the control system and the monitoring plan currently in place in Peru for certain bivalve molluses is able to deliver the guarantees required by Union law.

B.03 Exchange of views and possible opinion of the Committee on a draft Commission Implementing Decision amending Decision 2009/821/EC as regards the lists of border inspection posts and veterinary units in Traces. (PL/BS)

Commission Decision 2009/821/EC of 28 September 2009 drawing up a list of approved border inspection posts, laying down certain rules on the inspections carried out by Commission veterinary experts and laying down the veterinary units in TRACES, lays down a list of border inspection posts (BIPs) approved in accordance with Directives 91/496/EEC and 97/78/EC and a the list of central units, regional units and local units in the integrated computerised veterinary system (Traces). There are changes to the approvals of several BIPs in Belgium, Spain, France, Italy, Lithuania, The Netherlands and the United Kingdom and certain changes to the list of local Traces units in Italy.
