Monitoring (domestic pig / wild boar) continued in all *Laender*

-domestic pigs: risk based

-wild boar: fallen and shot

## Results (1)

- commercial	6,027	60,547	-
- backyard	96	540	-
<b>Wild boar</b>	-	<b>41,257</b>	<b>49,770</b>
- active	-	40,864	-
- passive	-	393	-

### **Tests in total** (domestic pigs and wild boar):

81,953 ELISA

18,535 PCR

4,247 virus isolation

1,858 other tests

→ **all 106,593 tests with negative results** (2014: 118,011 tests)

**No CSF-outbreaks in 2015 (domestic pigs and wild boar)**
