- Collective efforts of all sectors /authorities/international organisations
- Holistic approach to achieve concrete results
- Link with the global challenges (one health,
  AMR, food waste)

- 75 members of the platform
- 3 sessions:
  - Better <u>application</u> and understanding of EU legislation
  - Promotion EU animal welfare standards globally
  - Development and use of <u>voluntary</u> commitments



# Better application and understanding of EU legislation

- To share the best practices and pilot projects
- <u>Dissemination</u> and transfer of knowledge
- Better communication
- More need for <u>research</u>
- Improve <u>understanding</u> of the EU legislation to help in its <u>enforcement</u>
- Rules to be <u>implemented</u> in an even way across member states



# Better application and understanding of EU legislation

- Be <u>realistic</u> on what can be achieved,
- Take into account other <u>challenges</u> such environmental requirements, competitiveness issues etc.
- Requests to create <u>sub-groups</u>

- Apply EU standards for <u>imported</u> products
- <u>Education, training raising awareness</u> as key tools to promote AW in non –EU countries
- Favour an <u>outcome based approach</u>
- Good practices and transparent approach to lending policies





### Development and use of voluntary commitments

- Several animal welfare projects outlined (e.g. code for good breeding and reproduction, antibiotic free meat and castration by vaccination, etc.)
- Requests to create sub-groups
- Engagement from participants





## Development and use of voluntary commitments

- Labelling:
  - Some MSs presented their schemes



- Market acceptance of products
- Volatility of consumers, sensitivity to animal welfare in surveys but shopping preferences!
- Identify the criteria to develop schemes
- Extra cost to producers
- Dissemination of information on the benefits of animal welfare schemes, so that consumers would opt for the animal welfare labels.







#### **Some feedback: Twitter**

- <u>Balanced</u> and <u>constructive</u> tone from stakeholders
- <u>Neutral</u> and <u>positive</u> reactions to the establishment of the platform and to the Commission approach <u>to address priority issues</u> rather than everything at the same time
- Several proposals on the establishment of subgroups – on pig tail docking/pigs, rabbit welfare, illegal puppy trade, transport of live animals, equines, fish...


