

Food waste prevention: integral part of Circular Economy Package





Waste legislation – state of play

Political agreement reached (December 2017) – revision of Waste Framework Directive (COM(2015)595 final)

Food waste prevention: new obligations for Member States:

- reduce food waste generation at each stage in the food supply chain to progress towards SDG 12.3
- Monitor and report regularly on food waste levels, based on common EU methodology (Delegated Act)









SDG 12.3: By 2030, halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses.









EU Pilot Project: Food Redistribution

Overall aim:

 further investigate regulatory and operational frameworks for food redistribution in the EU



 facilitate the dissemination of the EU food donation guidelines and engagement with stakeholders in the EU-28.

<u>Timeline</u>: 2018-2020

EU guidelines: former food to feed: adopted 13 April 2018!

- Facilitate the safe feed use of former food, in line with "food use" hierarchy, and prevent food waste.
- Clarify application of relevant EU rules: food, feed and waste.
- Present best practice examples which comply with regulatory framework and prevent unnecessary administrative burden.





Date marking: next steps

- A multi-facetted, co-ordinated and coherent action plan is required by all key players
- Key objectives of policy actions:
 - improve the differentiation between the concepts of "use by" and "best before"
 - facilitate common understanding and use of date marking by all actors (industry, national competent authorities and consumers)

⇒Sub-group established – 20 April 2018






Over 50% of EU food waste is generated at household level

Food Safety


- 88 (± 14) million tonnes of food waste per year
- Equivalent of 20% of all produced food in EU
- 143 billion euros
- ~ 304 Mt CO2 eq (6% of total EU GHG emissions)
- 173 kilograms of food waste per person
