1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

There were no serious violations in the year 2018. Only non-systemic, individual cases of violations, which were mostly related to incorrectly completed documents, were recorded. Several cases were related to nonconformity to planned journey routes, one case was related to a missed 24-hour stop for animal rest. The most common nonconformity is the failure to return journey logs within the 1-month period of the journey. Corrective measures were applied to avoid the violations in the future. The cases, which involved transporters authorized by other Member States, were reported as laid down by Article 26 of Regulation 1/2005.

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

The action plan involves organizing annual training on relevant topics for SFVS official veterinary inspectors who perform the official control of animals during transport.
