

Low level of HPAI cases in wild birds, wild geese are affected

Active outbreak on 09/07/2024

Measures are in place,
Epidemiological investigation is ongoing
Protection and surveillance zone within NLD



Outbreak in lower saxony H5N7

Establishment with 91,000 laying hens

Increased number of deaths with clinical signs (respiratory diseases)

FLI examination results: July 1st, 2024 (H7N5, pathotyping still required)

FLI confirmatory finding: July 2, 2024 (H7N5 HPAI after sequencing)

01/07/2024 Killing of the animals on the farm (entire stock).

01/07/2024, Temporary restricted zone in accordance with Article 9 paragraph 1 letter c of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 within a radius of 3 km around the suspected establishment until the FLI's results were available on 2/07/2024 and the outbreak of HPAI has been confirmed in accordance with Article 11 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687.

In the temporary restricted zone, the measures set out in Article 7 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 (Article 9 paragraph 2 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687) apply.



Outbreak in lower saxony H5N7

On 02/07/2024, the restricted zone (protection and surveillance zone) was established

The preliminary cleaning and disinfection has been completed on 06/07/2024


Epidemiological investigations ongoing




Situation in **poultry** and **captive birds**

Period of time	Number of outbreaks
Active outbreaks on 09/07/2024	1
New from 26/06/2024 (~last PAFF) until 09/07/2024	1 Zoo: 0 Poultry: 1 NON-Poultry: 0
New season from 01/10/2023 until 09/07/2024	38 (37 lifted)
