

## HPAI in wild birds

26.10

- H5N8 confirmed in a mute swan
- found dead at Fehér-tó  
Csongrád county
- (resting place for migratory birds)


## 1st outbreak

Tótkomlós, Békés county- 03.11.

- fattening turkey farm
- 5 flocks - 10200 birds, closed technology
- increased mortality - feed toxicosis - private samples
- killing started on the 2nd of November - official samples
- laboratory confirmation of HPAI on 3rd of November

## Control measures

In accordance with Council Directive 2005/94/EC and  
Diagnostic Manual 2006/437

- restricted zones
- culling and safe disposal of the birds
  - method of culling
- movement restrictions
  - derogations





## Further measures in place

- Order of the CVO:
  - 3/2016. closed feeding of poultry in the whole territory of Hungary, closed, safe keeping of feed
- National Disease Control Centre
- Crisis Management Team
- awareness: TV, radio, internet

## Further outbreaks

### Kiskunmajsa, Bács-Kiskun county - 09.11

- 21500 mulard ducks, confirmed 9.11, culling by 10.11

### Bugac, Bács-Kiskun county - 11.11

- 3400 fattening geese and ducks, confirmed and culled 11.11

### Kisszállás, Bács-Kiskun county - 11.11

- 23000 ducks, confirmed 11.11, culling 13.11

### Kelebia, Bács-Kiskun county - 12.11


- 15000 ducks, confirmed and culled 12.11
- surveillance zone overlaps Serbian territories



## Further outbreaks

### Kiskunmajsa, Bács-Kiskun county – 18.11

- 17000 ducks, culling by 17.11
- preventive measures
  - order to kill all poultry flocks in 1km radius around avian influenza outbreaks in Bács-Kiskun county
  - Order of the CVO, 4/2016: closed keeping of poultry (or use of proper net in the outside areas) in Bács-Kiskun, Békés and Csongrád counties





## Further outbreaks

### Kiskunmajsa, Bács-Kiskun county - 18.11

- 3235+2900 geese, confirmed 18.11
- situated btw the two previously affected holdings

### Forráskút, Csongrád county - 21.11

- 40000 ducks, culling by 23.11

### Öcsöd, Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok county - 21.11

- 2500 geese, culling by 21.11

### Szank, Bács-Kiskun county - 25.11

- 20200 ducks, culling by 24.11

### Kömpöc, Bács-Kiskun county - 25.11

- 14 600 geese, culling by 23.11



## HPAI in wild birds

25.11

- H5N8 confirmed in a mallard
- sampling from a shot bird without clinical signs in Hajdú-Bihar county





## Secondary outbreaks

24 holdings close to the Kiskunmajsa outbreaks (Kiskunmajsa & Csólyospálos)

3 holdings close to Öcsöd outbreak

3 holdings close to Bugac outbreak

- 250 000 birds, all waterfowl
- mostly confirmed by testing of samples taken during eradication
- culling by 27th November


## Overview map

## Epidemiological investigation and tracing

- Source: wild birds
  - proximity of wetlands, migratory birds flying over the holdings, visual stains caused by them at the premises
- Tracing
  - No poultry have been moved from the affected holdings to EU Member States or Third Countries
- Experts assisting the LDCCs
- Active surveillance in wild birds – cooperation with BirdLife Hungary
- Increased surveillance program for poultry transports dispatched from Bács-Kiskun, Csongrád and Békés counties and from Kunszentmárton district of Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok county
