### **HPAI (H5N1)**

BG-HPAI(P)-2023-00001


- Farm: Quail farm;
- Primary outbreak;
- Location Sofia-region, Etropole village, Bulgaria;
- Suspicion: passive surveillance ( higher mortality);
- Confirmation 24.01.2023;
- ➤ Affected poultry 15 000;
- ➤ Culling and disposal 26-27.01.2023;
- ➤ Primary C&D 28.02.2023.



#### **HPAI (H5N1)**

BG-HPAI(P)-2023-00001

- Epidemiologically linked establishment –Quail hatchery;
- Location at the same place/ in once fenced area;
- > 11 000 hatched poultry;
- > Culling and disposal, C&D 28.02.2023.




Epidemiological investigations is still going on.

#### **HPAI (H5N1)**

BG-HPAI(P)-2023-00001

Activities in the restriction zones: - no industrial poultry farms

- → 3 km zone inventory and clinical surveillance completed as by 31.01.2023;
- ➤ 10 km zone completed inventory, clinical surveillance is still going on;



Restriction zones	No of settlements	No of back yards checked	No pf poultry
3 km zone	1	158	1703
10 km zone	9	208	1845

No suspicion for any infection disease has been notified so far.

#### **Additional measures**

- > Ban for outdoor keeping of poultry in the whole country;
- ➤ Awareness campaigns aimed at educating poultry keepers in the restriction zones;
- ➤ Enhanced surveillance (clinical and laboratory investigation; biosecurity checks) in poultry farms located in risk areas outside the restriction zones negative for Al Vi presence;
- > Training for official control in poultry farms (biosecurity checks and AI control).
