

Advisory Group 8 May 2020 COVID-19 - challenges for official controls



COVID-19 – situational analysis second half of March 2020

- Problems at external borders and between MS, food supply (food security)
- Prevention of spread of the virus limitation of movements of control staff, confinement measures
- Capacity of official laboratories
- Feasibility of on-the-spot checks



Specific issues beyond general situation (addressed by Guidelines for border management, green lanes etc.)





Temporary solution available to Member States

- Commission Implementing Regulation (EU)
 2020/466 of 30 March 2020
 - Safeguard measure, time-limited (1 June)
 - Option for Member States for all areas under OCR (notification to COM and to other MS)
 - Specific provisions:
 - Use of qualified natural persons other than control staff under certain conditions
 - Check of electronic documentation pending submission of original documents
 - Designation of other laboratories for analyses
 - Replacement of physical meetings by remote communication





Conclusion

- Time-limited specific tools for competent authorities in Member States
- Currently used across areas of OCR scope
- Substantial EU legislation not modified by the measure
- Discussion with MS on possible limited extension
