Name and description of the food in question

The request concerns (young) shoots of sunflower (Helianthus annuus).

Sunflower shoots refer to young shoots of sunflower, which are grown in a growing medium like other greenhouse salads. The growing time of shoots varies depending on the growing conditions, hence about 1-3 weeks. Sunflower shoots are about 5-10 cm in length when brought on the market. Sunflower shoots are brought to market as fresh produce with the growing medium or as pre-packed foods cut off from the growing medium.

According to the information provided, sunflower shoots are commonly grown in Finland and elsewhere in Europe for subsistence farming in private households. The sunflower shoots have also been used in speciality restaurants for vegan foods.
