## 3.1.1 Chlorpyrifos-methyl (090)

The EU <u>shares the view of JMPR</u> that MRLs cannot be proposed in the absence of residue trials matching with the relevant GAP:

- Cereals, expect maize and rice
- Rice, husked
- Rice, polished

The EU <u>would like to request the Codex Secretariat</u> to clarify the status of the existing CXLs of 10 mg/kg (Po) for wheat and 20 mg/kg (PoP) for wheat bran, unprocessed, and of the draft MRLs currently at Step 7 for barley; oats; rice; wheat; wheat bran, unprocessed and wheat, germ.

# 3.1.2 Spirotetramat (234)

The EU <u>shares the view of JMPR</u> that MRLs cannot be proposed in the absence of residue trials compliant with the Codex Sampling Guidelines:

However, the EU **considers** that MRLs can be proposed where data shows that field cutting does not affect the validity of the analytical results:

#### 3.2.1 Emamectin benzoate (247)

The EU would like to <u>introduce a reservation</u> to the toxicological endpoints, as at EU level a lower acute reference dose of 0.011 mg/kg bw is in place.

The EU would like to **comment** that the existing MRLs should be re-evaluated in view of the new acute reference dose that is proposed.

# 3.1.3 Tolfenpyrad (269)

The EU <u>supports</u> the conclusion of JMPR that there is no basis for a revision of the ARfD for tolfenpyrad.
