**European Community comments on  
Codex Circular Letter CL 2005/35 RVDF:**

**Request for comments at step 6 of the codex procedures on  
“Draft Maximum Residue Limits for Veterinary Drugs”  
(flumequine, pirlimycin, cypermethrin and alpha-cypermethrin  
and doramectin)  
(Appendices V of ALINORM 05/28/31)**

The European Community would like to submit the following comments regarding the draft MRLs for Veterinary Drugs mentioned below:

<b>Flumequine:</b>	The EC supports the proposed temporary Codex MRL for black tiger shrimps ( <i>P. monodon</i> ) . Nevertheless, the EC recommends that the proposed MRL would be extrapolated to “shrimps” as the EC does not consider that there is a need for such specificity.
<b>Pirlimycin:</b>	The EC supports the proposed Codex MRLs.
<b>Cypermethrin and alphacypermethrin:</b>	The EC supports the proposed Codex MRLs.
<b>Doramectin:</b>	The previous EC reservations on the practical compliance with the resulting discard time for bovine milk based on the proposed Codex MRLs are adequately reflected in the footnote. Thus the EC supports the proposed Codex MRLs including the proposed footnote.
