



In 2022-2023 in the three regions in total 650 PCR positive in WBs


Sardinia is not included because last PCR confirmation was in 2019

ASF cases in wild pigs and outbreaks in confirmed domestic pigs, during the last 15 days






Enlargement of Part I and Part II zones – Implementing Regulation (EU) 2023/594





Sardinia WB surveillance








Improvement of ASF epidemiological situation in the main

high risk areas

Seropositives are significantly decreasing since 2019

Seroprevalence in 2022-2023 is confirmed about 0%, and it is still decreasing
