Farm with laying hens Stable 1 5980 hens kept inside Stable 2 23.940 free range kept hens




General PCR is positive LPAI H7N7

Culling of the animals in stable 2 With CO₂ in the stable.

Cleaning and Disinfection completed

14 March Screening samples PCR negative

16 March All screening samples negative

3 April all restrictions lifted





Cleaning and Disinfection completed


Screening samples negative

1 km 2 commercial poultry farms


3 km 19 commercial poultry farms


