Reminder of obligations

- Article 185(3) Regulation (EU) 2016/429
 - The CA must make certain information concerning approved aquaculture establishments publicly available by electronic means, subject to data protection requirements i.e. name, address and registration number, type of production, species kept, up-to-date information on the health status
- Article 21(2) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/691
 - Additional up-to-date information concerning the health status of the aquaculture establishment i.e. disease-free, in an eradication programme, in a voluntary surveillance programme, any other information that pertains to a Category, B,C or D disease



Logistics

- MS provides the Commission with a link to their public register of aquaculture establishments
- Commission places that link on <u>Aquaculture establishments</u> -<u>European Commission (europa.eu)</u> beside the flag of the relevant MS



Current situation

- Several MS have provided a link to their public register and comply with requirements of Article 185(3) AHL and Article 21(2) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/691
- Other MS have provided a link to their public register, but the information still reflects the requirements of Directive 2006/88/EC
- A number of MS have not provided a link to their public register
- Contacted relevant MS directly a number of times all aware of obligations but websites were being updated, upgraded etc
