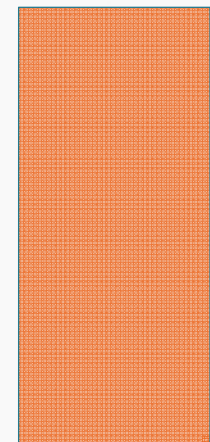

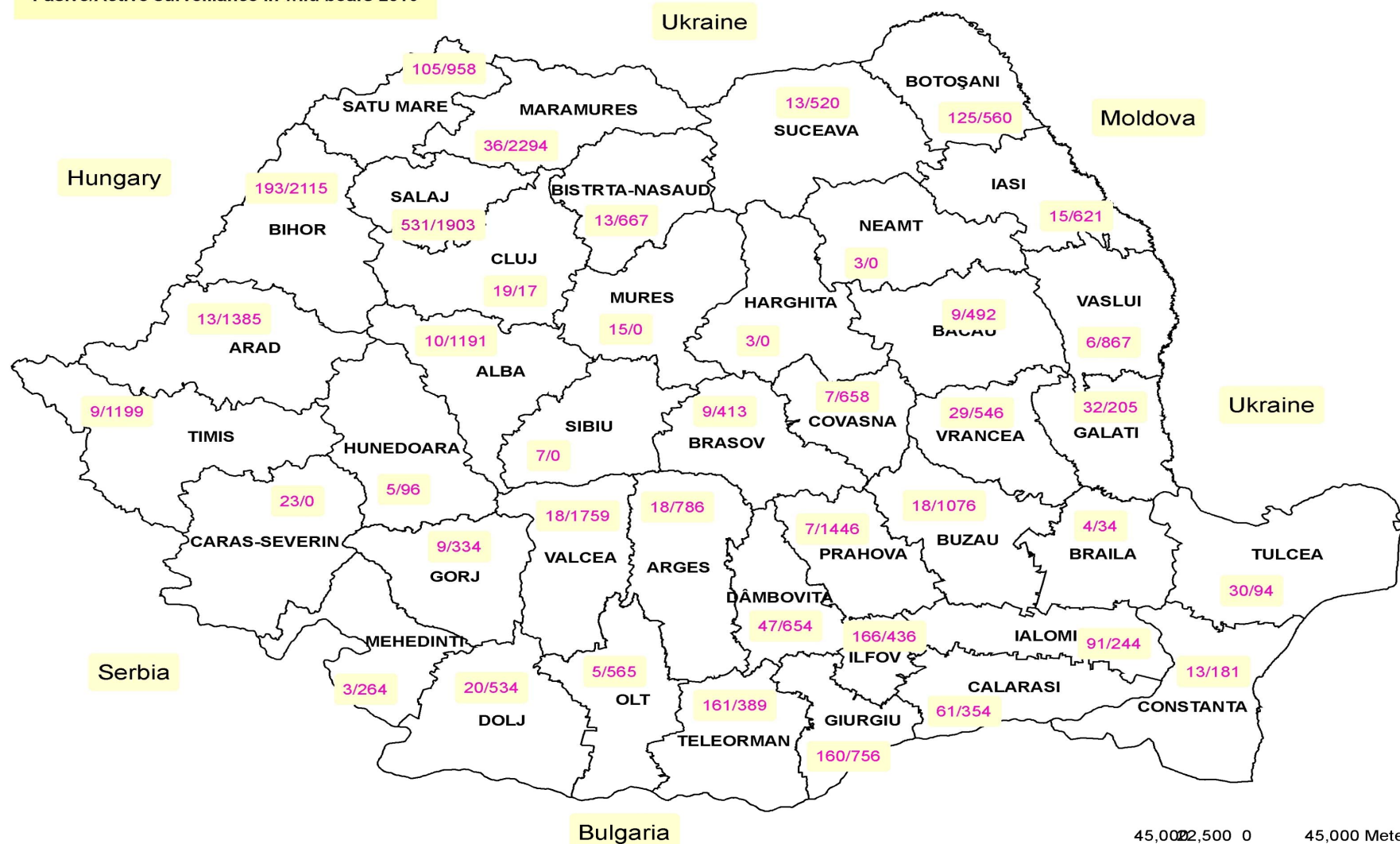

Passive/Active surveillance in wild boars 2019

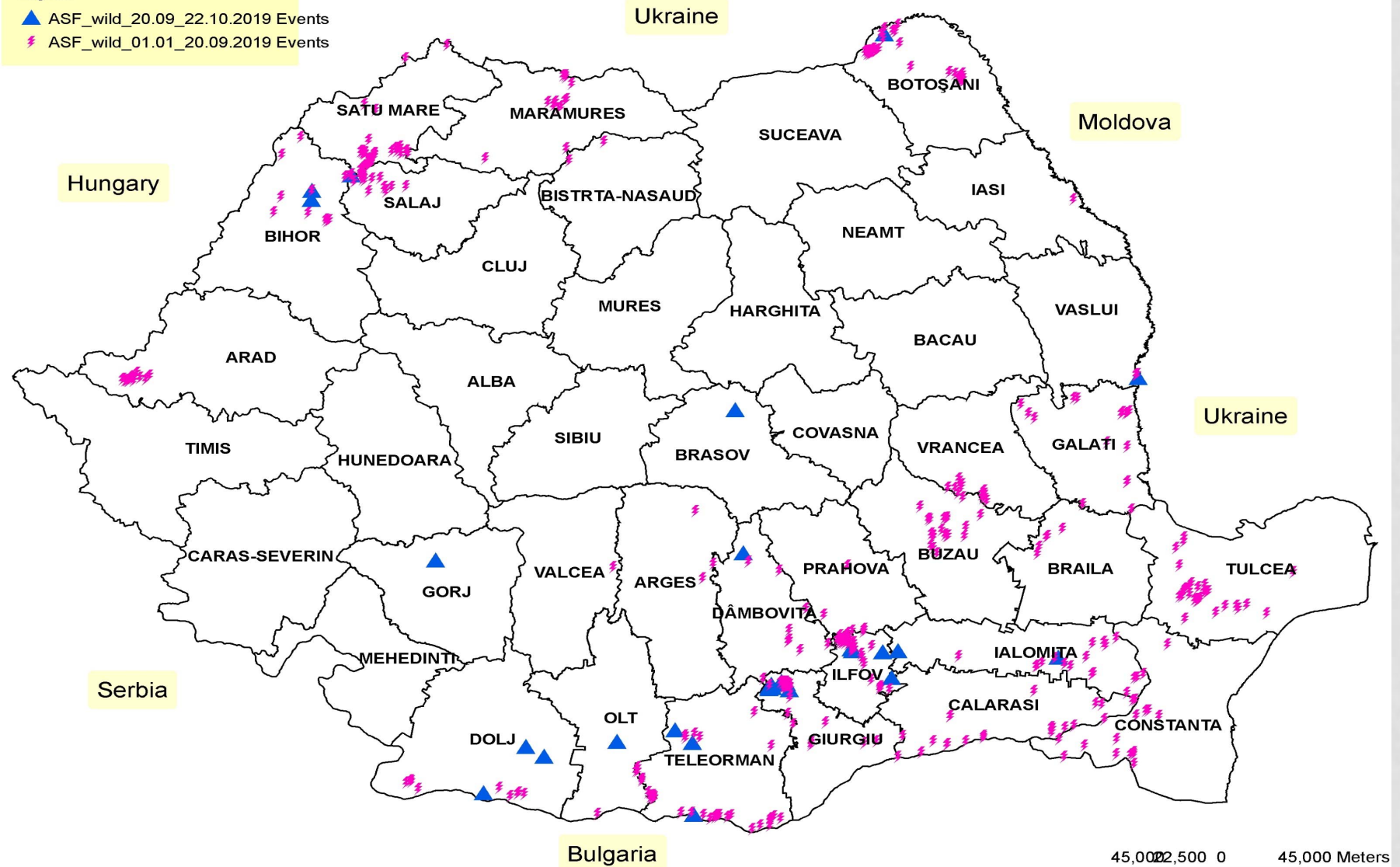

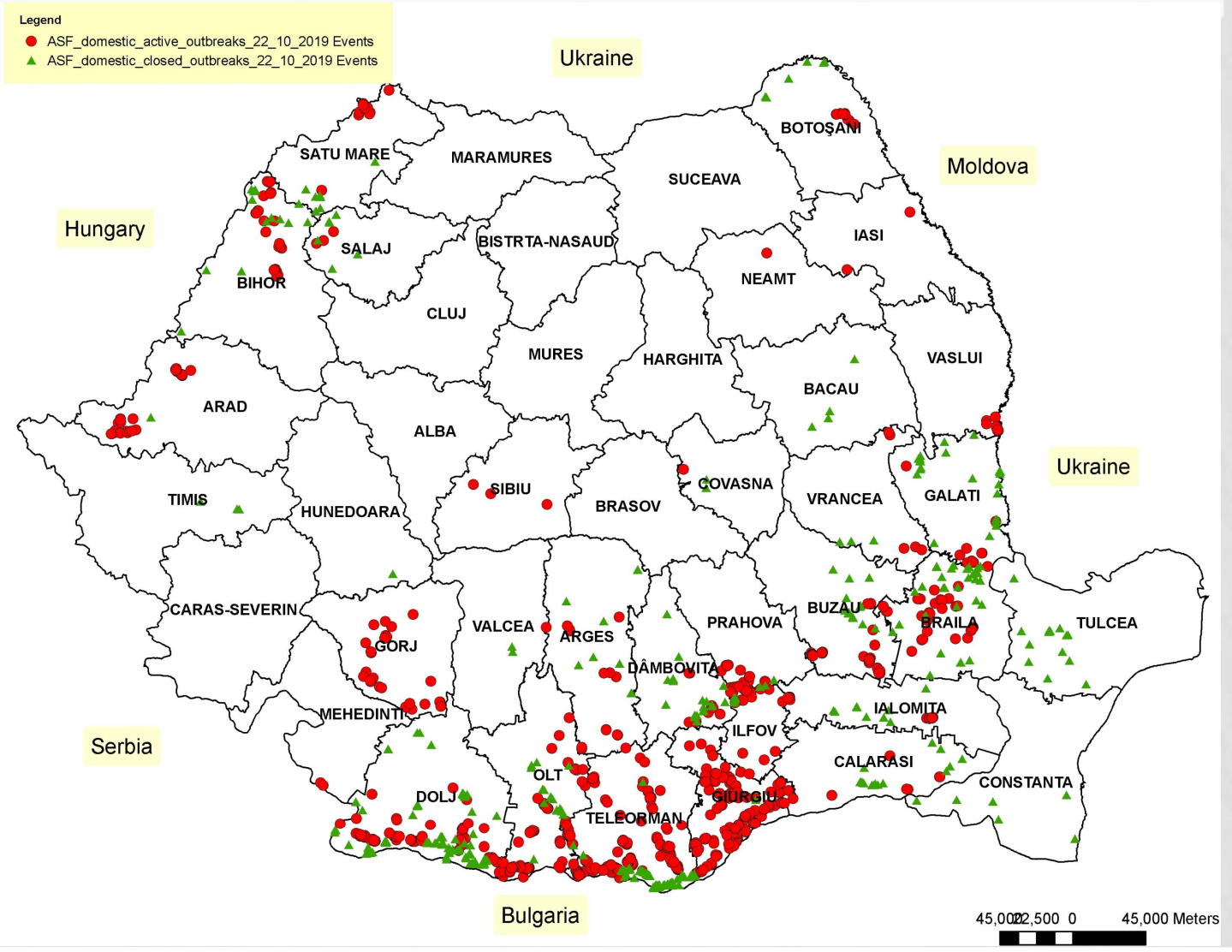

# REPOPULATION

Repopulation is permitted only after a risk analysis is carried out.

Guidelines for local competent authority:

- In areas infected with ASF in wild boar - no pigs enter or leave the holding, except where authorised by the competent authority having regard to the epidemiological situation. The restrictions are maintained 2 years from the last positive case.
- In the areas free of ASF in wild boar - it is allowed to repopulate, but it is required to verify the level of compliance with the legislation regarding biosecurity norms of pig holdings.

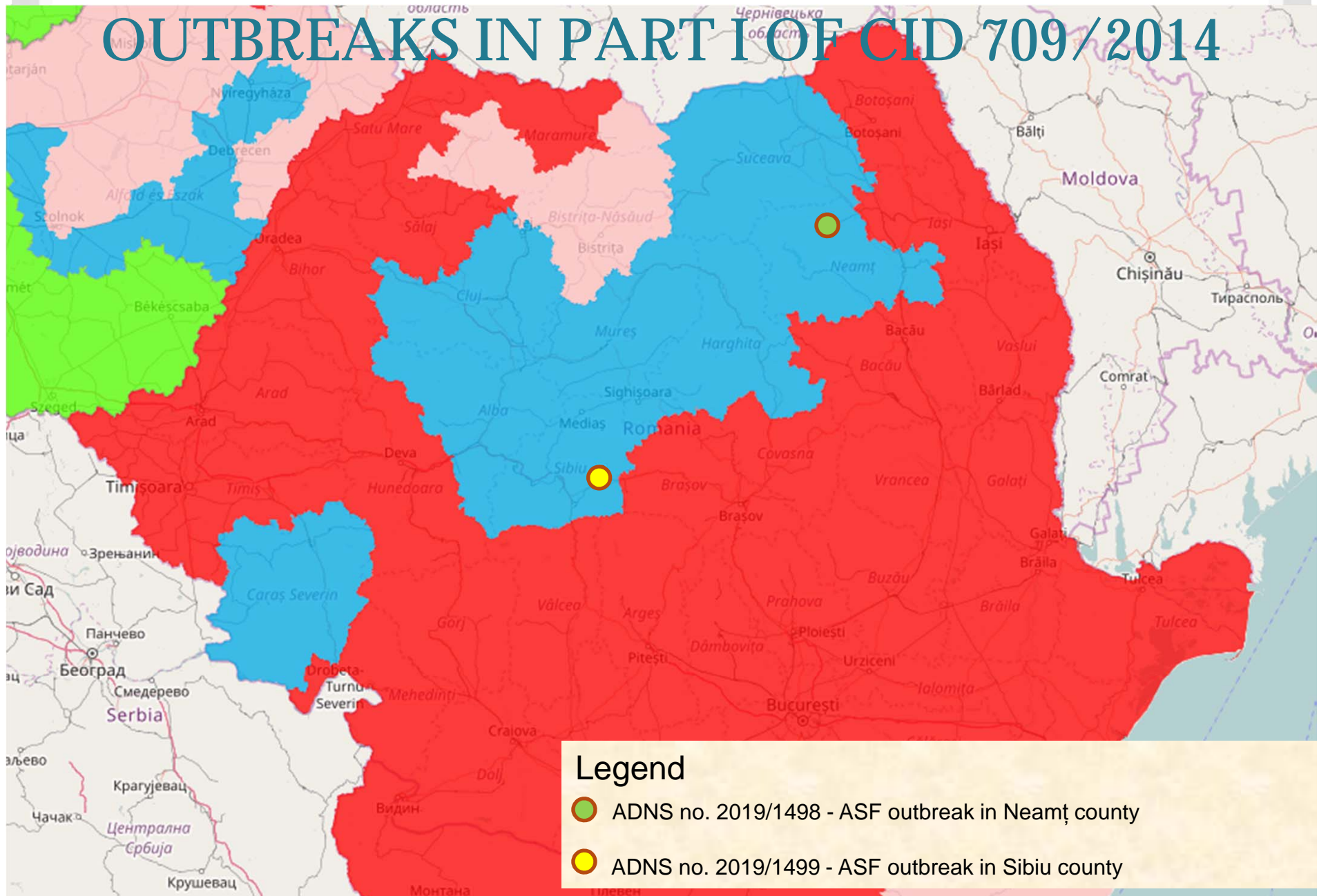
## SINCE LAST SCOPAFF outbreaks in Part I of CID 709/2014

**ADNS no. 2019/1498:** On 09.10.2019, the presence of ASF virus was confirmed in a backyard holding in **Neamț county**, included in Part I of CID 709/2014. Initially, in the holding there were 2 domestic pigs, stationary from April. On the night of October 6th to 7th, the two pigs died and the veterinarian was announced. Samples were taken and sent to the laboratory.

**ADNS no. 2019/1499:** On 10.10.2019, the presence of ASF virus was confirmed in a backyard holding in **Sibiu county**, included in Part I of CID 709/2014. Initially, in the holding there were one sow with 9 piglets. On 06.10.2019, the sow presented clinical signs: fever, ear cyanosis, lack of appetite, apathy. On 08.10.2019, the animal was killed, samples were taken – set of organs and sent to the laboratory. After the confirmation, the piglets were culled. The illegal trade with animals is the source of the disease. Along with other institutions, legal measures were applied.

The affected backyards were placed under official supervision, restrictive measures have been applied to the movement of people, animals, products, by-products and means of transport. The disinfection of the holding was carried out and the carcasses were rendered. Restriction zones were established according with EU Directive 60/2002 .

Draft amendment of Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development Order for <b>establishing the sizing of pig farms</b> in the territory of Romania	-published on October 21, 2019 for public consultation
Draft amendment of N.S.V.F.S.A. and Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development Order regarding <b>biosecurity norms in pig holdings</b>	-will be adopted after the adoption of the MARD Order for establishing the sizing of pig farms. -Transitional period 4 months. -Implementation estimate - April 2020
Draft amendment of Government Decision for increasing the amount of fines for breaching the rules imposed by veterinary legislation	- under approval

## RO ASF PLAN OF MEASURES (2)

MEASURE	TARGET
<p><b>National Disease Control Centre Decision nr.1/2019</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Portable <b>disinfection devices</b> are installed at the entrance and exit of markets, vegetable and fruit fairs</li><li>-<b>Pig raising is prohibited in isolated areas</b> like sheepfolds, forest cantons, etc.</li><li>-<b>Traffic controls</b> are being intensified. According with, these checks are carried out by joint teams of three institutions: IPJ (police), IJJ (gendarmes), and DSVSA (local veterinary authority).</li></ul>	-permanent
Instructions/ meetings / trainings with Local Competent Authority in order to improve the <b>epidemiological investigations</b> and to determine the source of the disease.	- permanent
