

ASF cases and outbreaks in Poland





Since the previous SCPAFF report further cases (23rd - 30th) of ASF in wild boar have been detected in Poland

ASF cases and outbreaks in Poland






The ASF cases are occuring in the same area (parts of 2 districts in Podlaskie region)

Developement of strategy



For 2015 it is planned to reduce the number of wild boar tested in the buffer zone:

- Currently all the WB found dead and shot in the buffer zone are tested
- The plan is to test:
 - Passive: All the WB found dead;
 - Active: All the WB, carcasses of which are to be moved outside the buffer zone
 - Active#2: The number of above mentioned WB must meet a treshold set for each area (based on a risk assesment); if not enough wild boar carcasses would be tested for movement purposes, a number of additional shot WB is going to be tested to meet the
