Article 50(1)-(3)

Certificates and documents accompanying consignments
+ **split consignments**

- Certificates/documents (electronic equivalents)
[...] ⇒ **presented to + kept by** CA BCP unless
otherwise provided for in Art. 1(2) rules
- CA BCP ⇒ copy certificates/documents (copies for
split consignments)
- Consignments shall not be **split** until official
controls have been performed + CHED finalised
in accordance with **Art. 56(5) + Art. 57**

Article 56(5)

The CA BCP shall finalise the CHED as soon as:

- (a) all **controls** required by **Art. 49(1)** = **performed**
- (b) **results** from physical checks (where required) = **available** and
- (c) **decision** on the consignment **taken** in accordance with **Art. 55** + **recorded** on the **CHED**

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Article 50(4)

The Commission is empowered to adopt **delegated acts** in accordance with **Article 144** to supplement this Regulation concerning rules establishing the **cases** where, and the conditions under which, the **CHED** is required to **accompany** consignments of the categories of animals and goods referred to in **Article 47(1)** to the **place of destination**.

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OCR Recital 60



For the purpose of organising an efficient system of official controls, consignments arriving from TCs which require **controls at their entry** into the Union should be accompanied **CHED** to be used

- for **prior notification** of the arrival of consignments at BCP
- to **record**
 - the **outcome** of official controls performed and
 - **decisions taken** by the CA on the consignment they accompany
- to obtain **clearance by customs** authorities once all official controls have been performed

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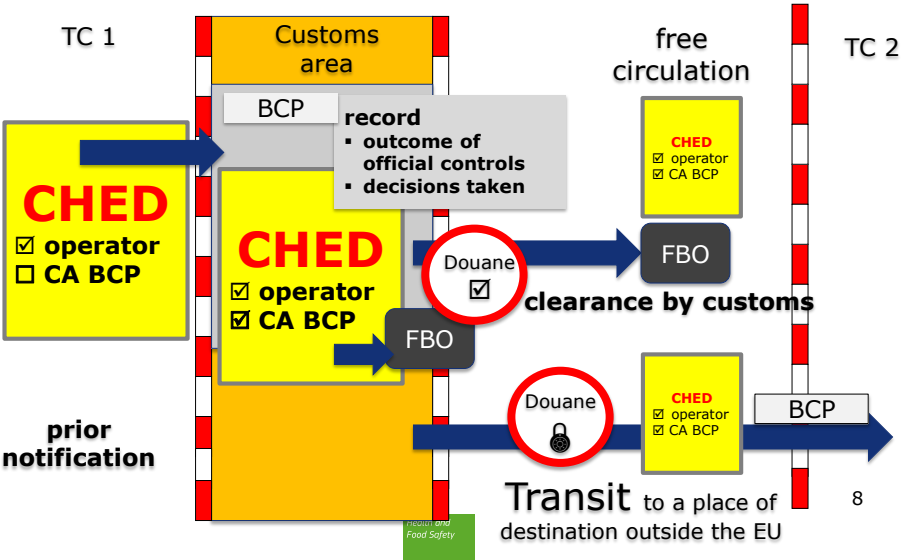




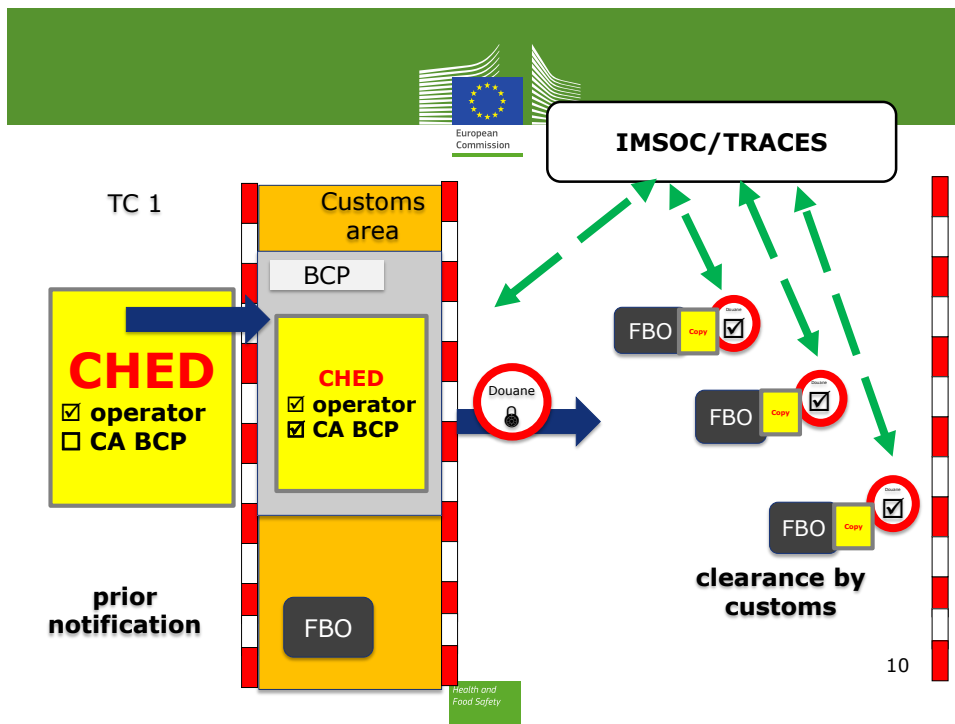
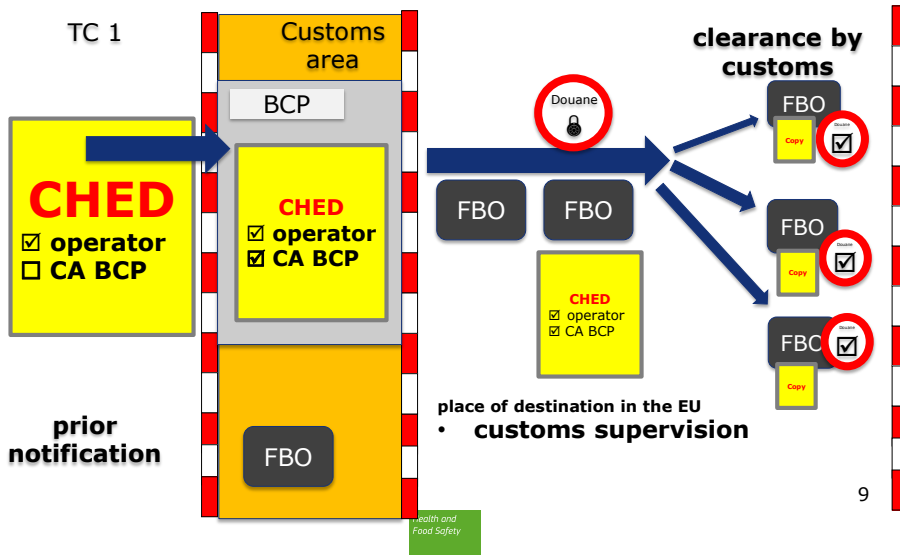
