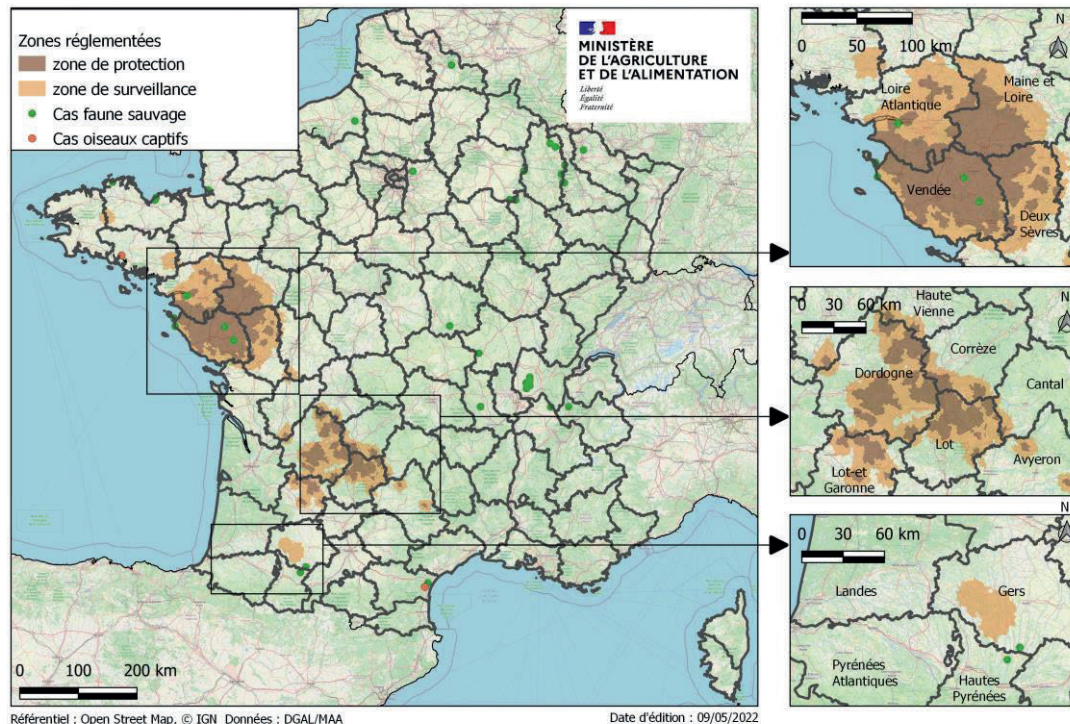

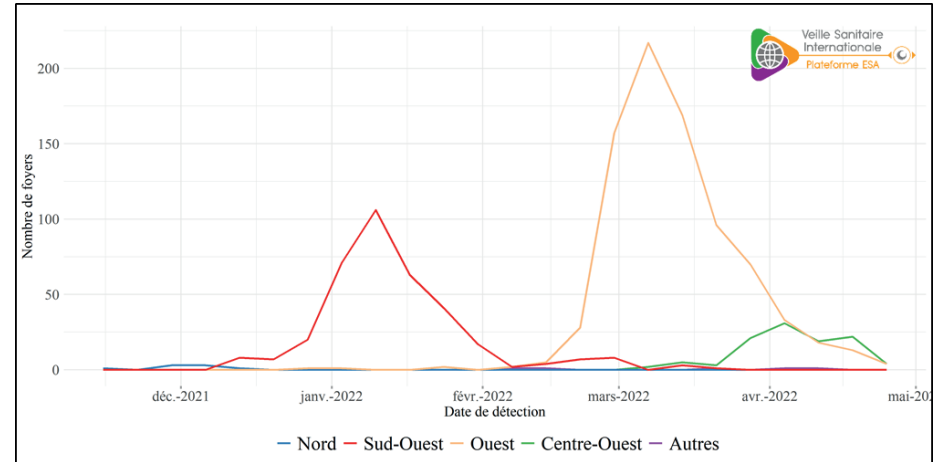
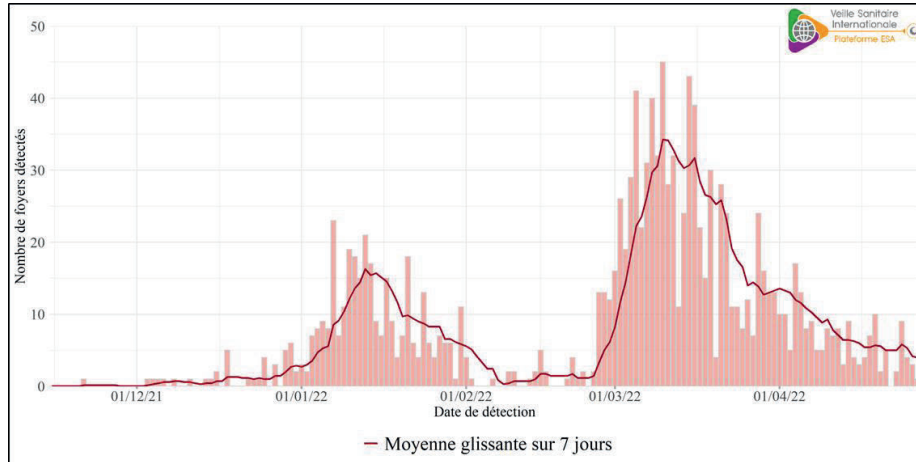

# HPAI 2021/2022 : 3 waves

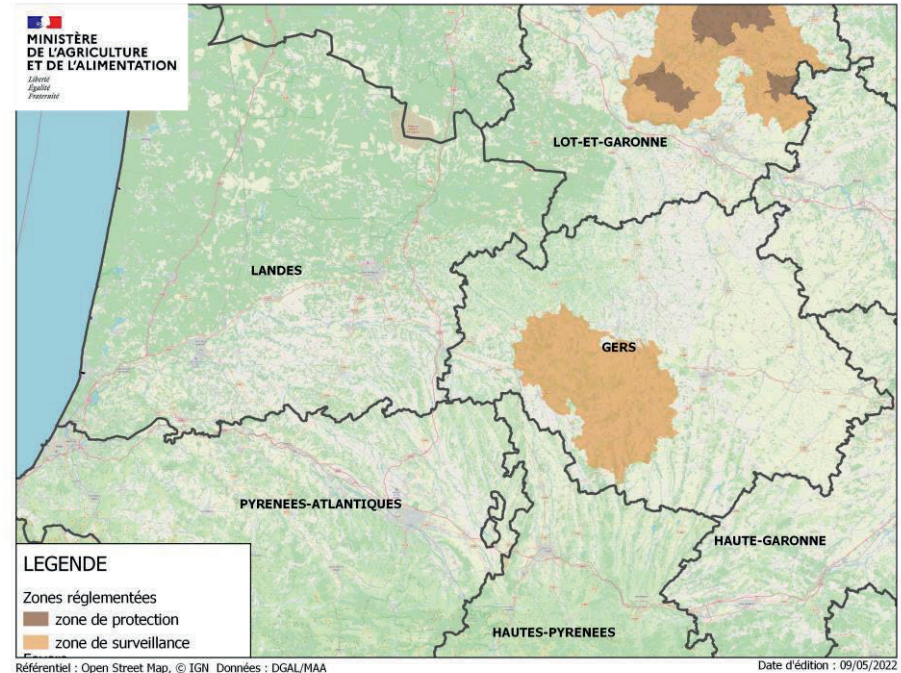


- 11/26/2021 in **Northern France** : 8 outbreaks, mainly in *Gallus*
- 12/16/2021 in **South-East France** : mainly in ducks but also other birds
- Mid-February 2022 in **Western France** (Pays de la Loire)
- April 2022 in **Western-Central France**

# South-West (as of 05/05/2022)

- **364** confirmed outbreaks
- No more outbreaks in the coalescent area
- Lifting of restricted zones
- Outbreaks in Lot-et-Garonne in relation with West-Central area

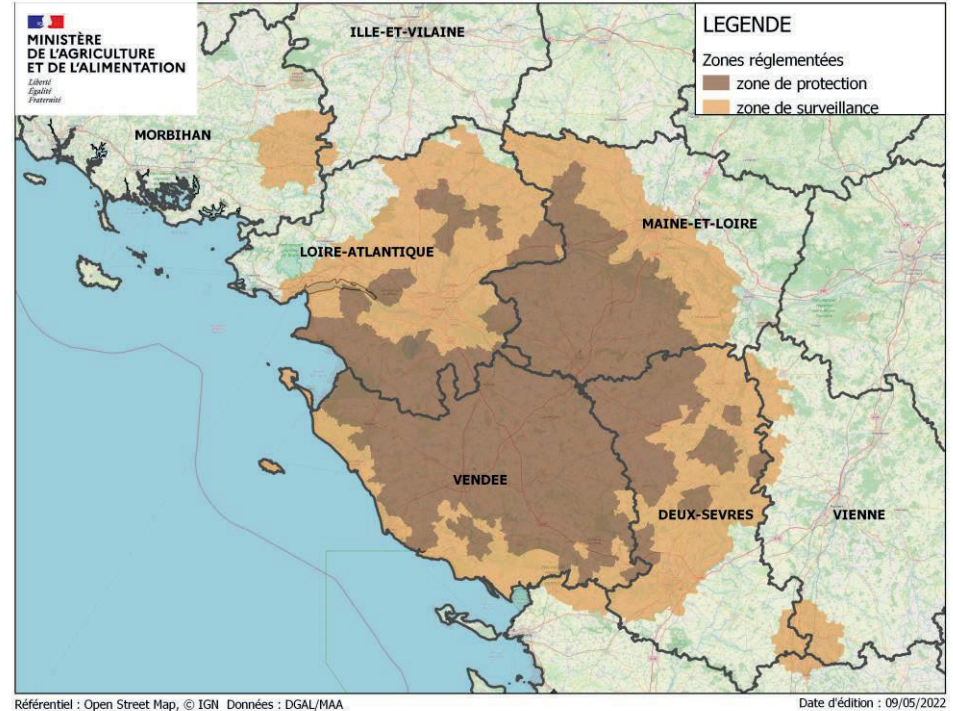

# West (as of 05/05/2022)

- **858** confirmed outbreaks
- 1 coalescent area in departments 44, 49, 79 et 85
- No new outbreaks in Brittany
- **Preventive depopulation:**
  - Around sensitive sites (all poultry)
  - Of palmipeds and turkeys
- *NB : in 2016/2017 and 2020/2021 very limited number of outbreaks*

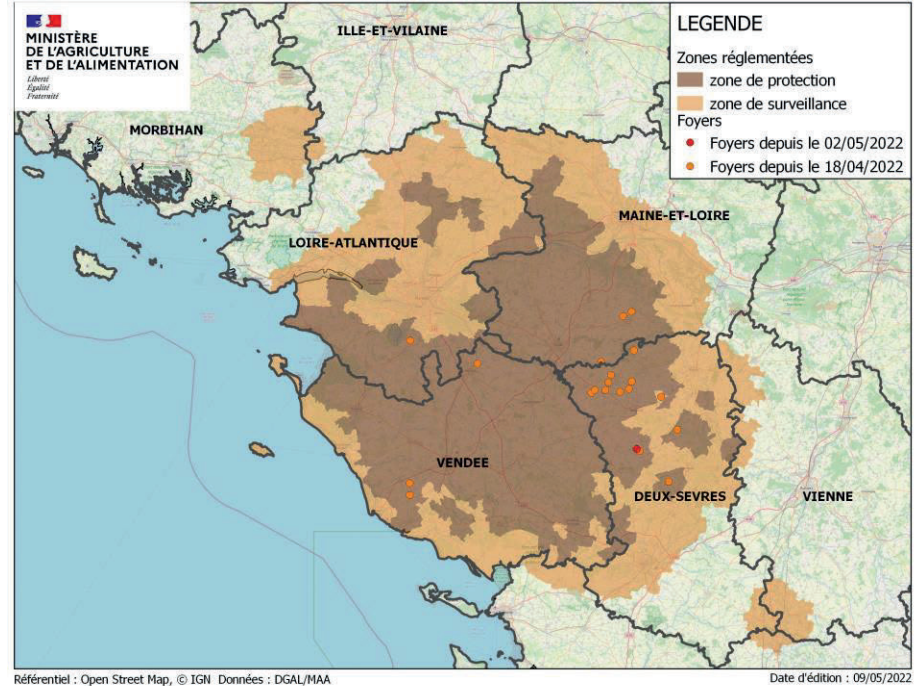
Zones réglementées et foyers IAHP dans l'Ouest



# West (as of 09/05/2022)

- Large decrease in the number of cases over the past 4 weeks
- This map represents two stabilization periods (8 days and 21 days without new outbreaks) and shows a eastward movement of the infection dynamics

# Re-population in West

## Criteria used to develop re-population :

- **Area Stabilization** : no new HPAI outbreak confirmed since 21 days
- Implementation of a sanitation period (4 weeks)
- **Regional approach** : coherent geographical perimeters constituting the same epidemiological entity
  - ✓ Coalescent area
  - ✓ Surrounding coalescent area

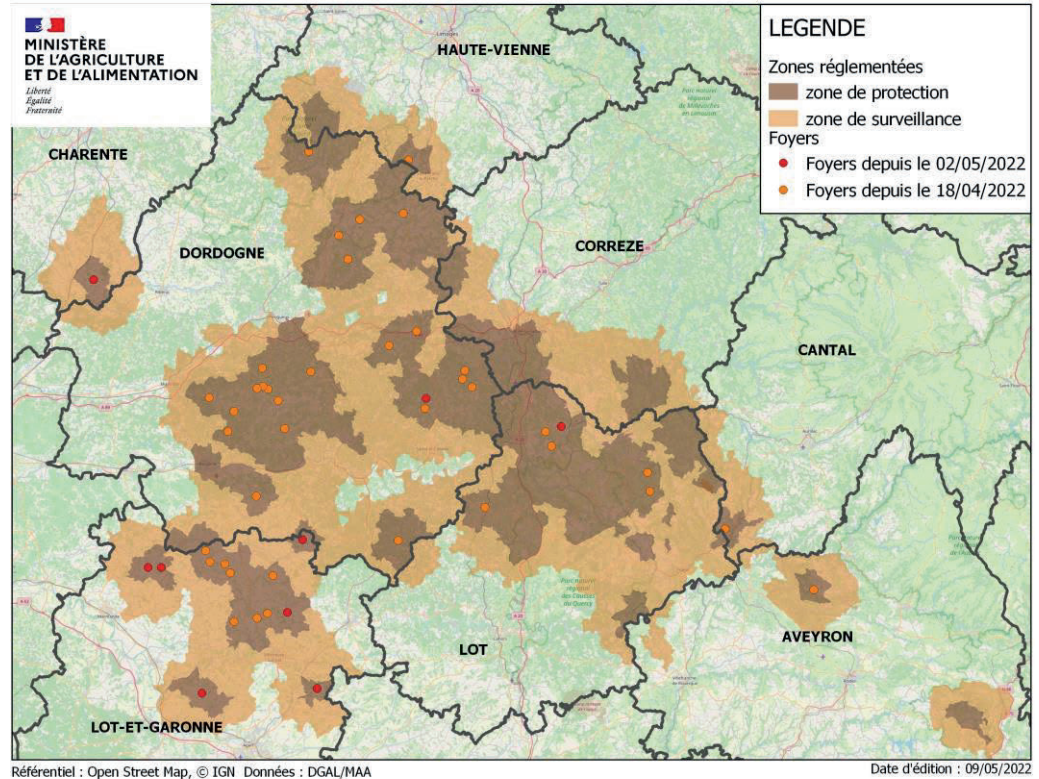
# Western Central (as of 05/05/2022)

- **123** confirmed outbreaks

- **8 departments:**

Aveyron (12), Cantal (15),  
Charente (16), Corrèze (19),  
Dordogne (24), Lot (46), Lot-et-  
Garonne (47), Haute-Vienne (87)





# National decree 9 May 2022

## Modification of level of HPAI risk to take into account the favorable sanitary situation :

- **Keeping "HPAI High risk level" → 19 departments**  
(= departments most particularly affected during the 2021-2022 epizootic and departments adjacent to these departments).
- **Lowering at "Moderate risk level" → other departments**
  - Sheltering of all kept animals only in wetland areas  
(Zone à risque particulier)
