

1. Introduction

This document sets out the inspection programme of DG Health and Consumer Protection for 2006 with a detailed plan for January to December. It is estimated that around 260 inspections will be completed in this 12 month period.

Careful consideration has been given - together with competent authorities in Member States - to the scheduling of inspections in Member States to avoid a disproportionate burden by control visits during a particular period.

There is always a degree of uncertainty attached to any SANCO inspection plan. Of necessity, it must remain flexible to enable it to respond to emergencies and unforeseen circumstances. As in previous years, adjustments to the plan will be required as the year progresses. Inspections in response to emergencies can only be made by cancelling or postponing planned missions. Also, the carrying out of certain inspections will depend on the timely availability of resources.

An update of the programme will therefore be presented in June 2006.

2. Balance of inspections

2.1. Balance of inspections on food safety, animal health, animal welfare and plant health

A total of 270 inspections are planned for 2006. Inspections in the food safety area make up the main part of the programme, roughly 64%. 16 and 7% of inspections, respectively, will be carried out in the animal health and welfare areas, however, following the "farm to fork" approach, a large number of food safety inspections also cover animal health and welfare elements. 7% of inspections deal with plant health and the same proportion will be general reviews.

2.2. Geographical balance

The majority of inspections will take place in the European Union (59%). 11% of inspections are planned in the acceding and candidate countries, while 30% of inspections will be in third countries.

3. Inspections in Member States

A number of new series of audits and on-the-spot inspections will commence in 2006:

- o Official controls on products of animal origin
 - This series is a follow-up to series carried out in 1999 to 2001 and will also look at aspects of new legislation coming into effect from 2006. The inspections cover a wide range of sectors and products (meat of domestic ungulates, farmed game, wild game, minced meat, meat products and preparations, MSM (mechanically separated meat), milk and milk products, stomachs, bladders, intestines, gelatine, collagen) and will also include BSE measures in meat establishments as well as animal welfare aspects in slaughterhouses.
- Table eggs (Salmonella enteritidis and typhimurium) and Salmonella control programmes in the poultry sector
 - The control of this important zoonosis will take place in the table egg and/or poultry sectors in various EU countries, chosen according to the importance of



production and trade of eggs and poultry in the EU. Follow-up to different outbreaks as well as the management of EU co-financed programmes are further aspects to look into.

o Intra-community trade in live animals

Outbreaks of animal diseases can have a vast economic impact and, in the case of zoonoses, present also a risk to human health. Trade volume as well as EU cofinancing of eradication programmes influenced the selection of Members States visited. Sheep identification, bluetongue and brucellosis will be specific inspection elements in a number of Member States.

Animal welfare of pigs

Although the majority of animal welfare inspections follow-up previous inspections on the themes 'farm – transport – slaughter' or 'welfare of calves and laying hens on farms', the welfare of pigs in the farming sector will be included in all missions.

o Imports/movements of plants for scientific purposes

This important pathway for introduction and/or spread of organisms harmful to plants will now be specifically examined in a few selected Member States following a desk study of the entire Community.

In addition to these new inspection topics, the programme 2006 includes various ongoing series and follow-up inspections (dioxin residues in fish and fish oil originating from the Baltic region, pesticide residues, animal nutrition, TSE and animal by-products, genetically modified food and feed, animal welfare and plant health) as well as ongoing controls such as on import controls, both on live animals and products of animal origin, and on food of plant origin and feed.

The following series will be concluded in 2006:

- o Pesticide residues
- o Dioxin residues in fish/fish oil originating from the Baltic region

General review missions are a new horizontal type of inspections introduced in 2005. Their objective is to carry out an overall review of follow-up to FVO report recommendations and to assist in completing country profiles for all Member States by mid-2007.

The above-mentioned audits and inspections will be supplemented by several desk analyses. In preparation for inspections planned for 2007, assessments will be carried out on the following subjects:

- o Infant and baby milk, baby food
- o Imports/movements of plants for scientific purposes
- Dioxin residues in fish oil originating from the UK.

4. Inspections in acceding and candidate countries

In anticipation of further accession to the EU in 2007 and beyond, the Food and Veterinary Office works steadily to contribute to the readiness of acceding and candidate countries. 2006 will see inspections on a wide range of food safety, animal health and welfare and plant health issues to assess countries' readiness for accession and to evaluate progress in relation to previous recommendations. Inspections will take place in particular in the two acceding countries Bulgaria and Romania, but also in the candidates Croatia and Turkey. General reviews of follow-up to FVO recommendations and with a view to continuing the development of country profiles, will accompany the programme in candidate countries.

5. Inspections in third countries

In third countries, the FVO needs to ensure that competent authorities correctly apply relevant EU standards or their equivalent with respect to animals, plants and products countries export to the European Union.

The majority of audits and inspections will focus on the assessment of eligibility/approvals for export. Thereby, third countries have been selected for the programme by size of the existing trade and by the risks the products and animals exported to the EU present for human and animal health. In addition, notifications to the rapid alert system for feed and food (RASFF) also play an important role in prioritising inspections.

While the main part of these inspections is targeted at a review of existing approvals of major trade partners and follow-up to previous missions, there are also a number of new requests for approval which will need to be evaluated. The readiness of application files (such as, for example, timely replies by competent authorities to pre-mission questionnaires), but also certain specific regional circumstances (e.g. climatic, security considerations), are major conditions for the completion of the inspection programme. Therefore, a number of third country inspections can only be programmed provisionally at this stage.
