# Detection of listed diseases

- Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 - **Article 4** - Union reporting on the detection of listed diseases: Member States shall report to the Commission and to the other Member States **by 30 April of every year**, covering the previous calendar year, on the detection of category E diseases that have been confirmed in their territory in listed species and groups of listed species referred to in the table set out in the Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1882
- Action required for non-submitted reports:  
EDIT the draft report for 2021 or 2022 or 2023 and check the data & submit





# Annual reports of approved eradication programmes

**Article 7** of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/2002 on Union reporting on the detection of listed diseases:

- Member States shall report to the Commission **by 30 April** of every year, on the results of the implementation of their ongoing approved eradication programmes
- Currently, there are 45 approved eradication programmes

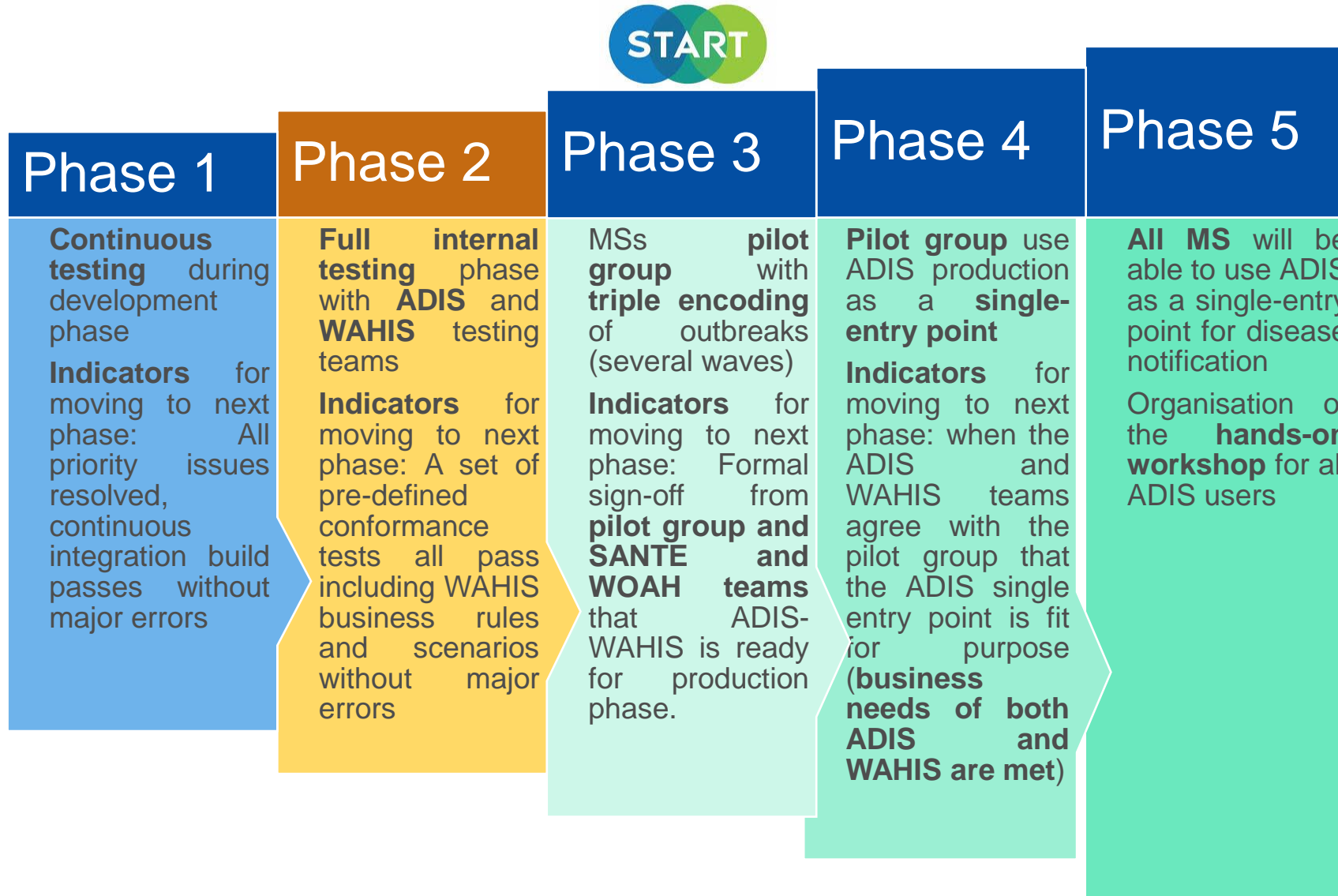

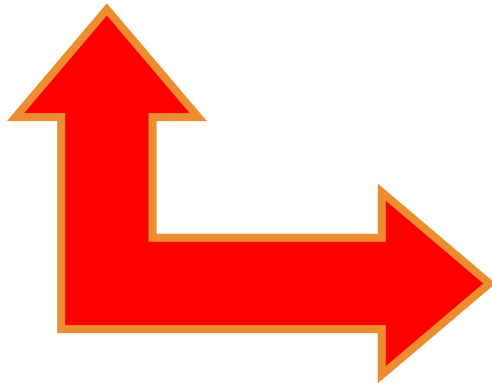

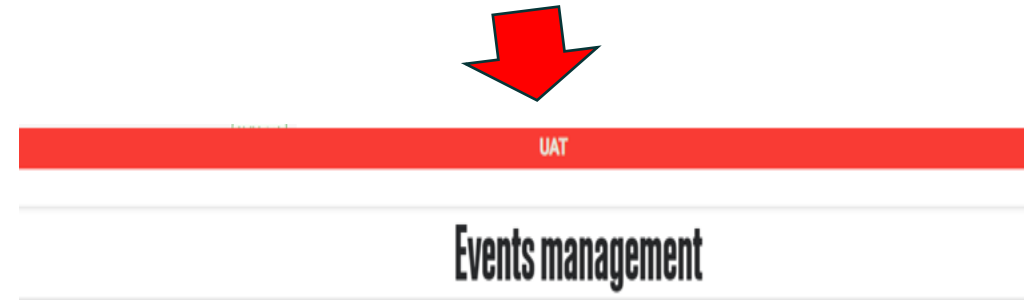

# ADIS Pilot Phase – Next Steps

- Current testing wave ongoing till next week
- More complicated scenarios to be tested in next wave
  - Test the Join Management Procedures
  - Test more remote (and unlikely) scenarios
- Feedback to this and next testing waves will be instrumental for go live date (only for Pilot Member States)
- At the WOAH General Session there will be a dedicated **WAHIS+ADIS** kiosk as well as side event on Wednesday 29 of May

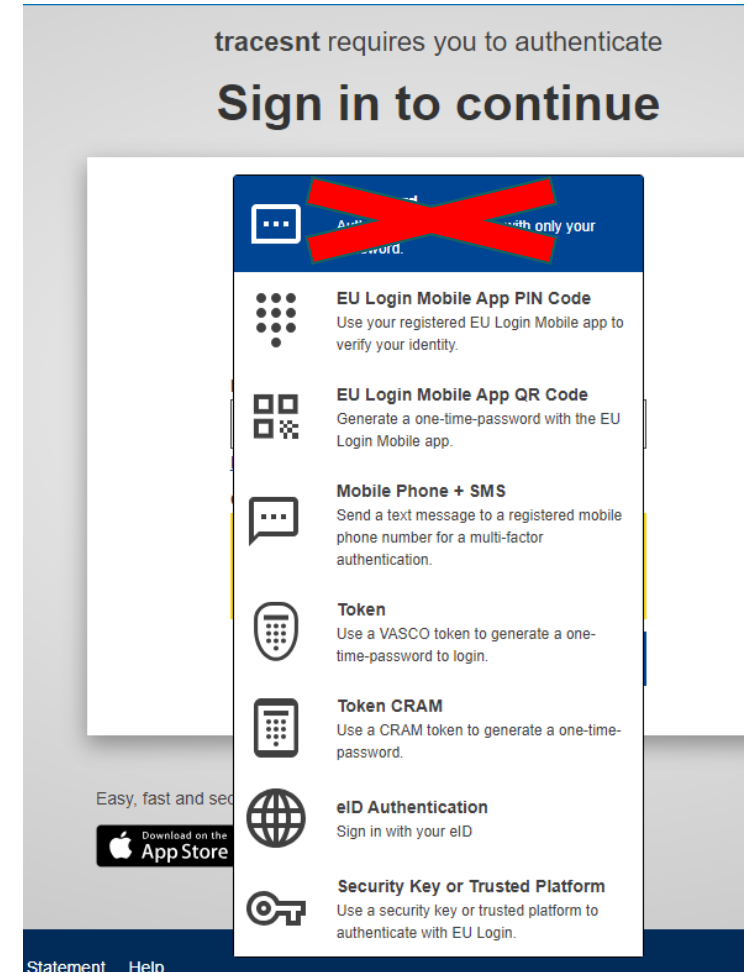
# MFA (Multi Factor Authentication)

# Multi-factor authentication (MFA)

- MFA is **mandatory** for all Commission systems handling "SNC" data (SNC = Sensitive Not Classified)
- MFA in IMSOC (incl. ADIS) is planned for **11/06/2024**
- Current status: only **13%** of all TRACES users have MFA (Jan 2024)
- Please **pass the message at home to set up MFA**, several options exist; explained in more detail on the following slide
- You can activate more than one MFA option
- You only need to use MFA once it's active in TRACES

# EU Login MFA Options

- **EU Login Mobile App** with
  - PIN code / fingerprint (requires internet connection)
  - QR code (no internet connection needed)
- One-time code by SMS
- Physical token
- National ID card and reader (in some MS)
- Security key on your PC (on some platforms)
- EU Login remembers your last selection and you can change it.

# Union Notification regulated by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/2002

# Comm. Imp. Regulation (EU) 2020/2002

- Article 3 requires notification within 24h (for **primary outbreaks**) within 24 hours of confirmation
- On a weekly basis (for **secondary outbreaks**)
- Since 2023 over 22.000 outbreaks were notified in ADIS
- ADIS is used by Member States and neighbouring countries
- Regular scrutiny on timeliness of notifications
