The first EU Reference Centre for Animal Welfare



- Operational since October 2018
- Focus on the welfare of *pigs*
- Work programme 2018
- Mapping out current structures and activities
- Planning 2019-2022 activities

Coordinated Control Plan on online sales of dogs and cats

- Recommendation adopted by the Commission in August 2018
- Non bidding but wide support from Member States
- Results of the checks expected first half 2019

Pilot project on pig castration

- Pilot project from the European Parliament
(budget 2017)
- A study on best practices to prevent surgical castration of pigs (now completed)
- Soon published

EFSA mandate on killing

- The *World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE)* started to review the OIE Terrestrial Code Chapters of slaughter and killing
 - The Commission
 - is part of the OIE ad hoc group
 - has sent an EFSA mandate in August 2018
